Parent Code of Conduct Morgantown Hockey Association

1. Zero Tolerance for Physical or Verbal Aggression Under no circumstances will physical confrontations, threats, or verbal altercations with same-team parents, players, or coaches be tolerated. Aggressive behavior, including shouting, swearing, or intimidating actions, will result in immediate disciplinary action, which may include removal from the event or suspension from future team activities.
2. Calm and Respectful Communication Approach disagreements calmly and respectfully. Use constructive language to express concerns without resorting to personal attacks or hostility. Avoid confrontations during games, practices, or team events. If an issue arises, wait for an appropriate time to address it privately and professionally.
3. Follow Proper Channels for Conflict Resolution Bring concerns to the attention of the coach or team manager rather than addressing them directly with the involved party in a heated moment. If the issue remains unresolved, escalate it to the Level Director following the established conflict resolution process.
4. Lead by Example Model good sportsmanship and emotional control for the players. Show them that conflicts can be resolved through dialogue and mutual respect rather than anger or aggression. Remember that your behavior directly impacts the team dynamic and your child's experience.
5. Maintain a Safe Environment Prioritize the safety and well-being of everyone involved. If you witness or are involved in a potentially harmful situation, do
