Freeze is at the beginning of January.

- Pay City of Medina taxes \$1,690.60

Treasurer's Report: Tim Jewell

Waiting for two more treasurers for Junior Gold. Opened the account at Hunting with 4.9% interest as approved at the last meeting. PIC has ice that teams can add. JHill will send out available ice and teams can sign up and then add costs to their assessments.

Hockey Operations: (Miles Death)

- JG16 White: some Armstorng Cooper and Orono players helped to fill out the team's roster. They had two goalies quit, and now they have one that has offered to play.
- Alumni Wall: KJ Branding is working on a layout. Physical project to begin in 3-4 weeks.

Only a few volunteer sessions are open for the scheduled tournaments. Picture days went well.

Registrar: Sarah Cook

 Registration is officially closed. Last of JrG players have been rostered. Locker Room Monitors deadline was November 22nd. Some coaches are being added to the roster, and once their requirements are complete, they will get added. Opened registration in August and closed in early October for next year. Communicate about the change in dates more over social media. If there are updates to the registration process, SCook has asked for board members to email her with those requests and ideas.

Membership and Operations: Tia Senenfelder

- Will be replacing the keyboard sleeves in the scoreboard consoles.
- Scoreboard Training went well. About 35 people attended.
- Audio Systems: have we explored updating this? Is there a way to plug in devices? PIC
 C is not good, and PIC B is in need as well as the speakers do not work. Eric did work
 on the system in PIC A, so he would be a good resource.
- Aesthetics at PIC: TSenenfelder provided examples for discussion:
 - Banner System: frame that allows for swapping out banners based on happenings at PIC for our association. The structure is \$200 and comes with one vinyl message. Approximately \$100 for additional banners.
 - Step and Repeat: mock ups for photo opportunities during tournaments. This is about \$850 for the frame.
 - Exterior Flags are an option as well. These are \$400 each.
 - JHIII suggested an approval of \$2500 to spend on hosted tournament signage.
 MUgurlu moved to approve; seconded by CPeterson. Motion approved.
- Content for next newsletter will include information regarding the donation to City of Plymouth for a 4th Rink, jersey and apparel surveys, ordering deadline for Lettermen, Code of Conduct reminders, timing to expect next block of dates on the Crossbar schedule.
