WYHA GOOD STANDING POLICY

This policy outlines the requirements for maintaining “Good Standing” with Wayzata Youth Hockey Association (WYHA).

Good Standing is defined as:

- Association Volunteer Hours from previous season fulfilled
- Assessment Fees from previous season are paid in full
- No outstanding Code of Conduct violations
- All borrowed WYHA equipment has been returned or return arrangements have been made with WYHA

Due to system limitations, WYHA cannot prevent a player who is “not in Good Standing” from Registering. The identification of lack of Good Standing will occur at the Tryout or Rostering stage.

PROCESS FOR RETURNING TO GOOD STANDING

If you are notified you are not in Good Standing, your contacts for questions and returning to Good Standing are:

For matters related to a balance due - the VP of Administration, Registrar or Membership & Operations Manager are the points of contact to assist you. These contacts will provide you with the outstanding balance(s) due and confirm when they are paid in full.

In regards to Code of Conduct violations, the VP of Administration is the point of contact for questions.
