Overview

Team Wyoming represents the top youth players across the state, providing an opportunity for athletes to compete together in a high-performance environment. Coaches play a key role in supporting skill development, fostering team culture, and upholding USA Hockey's American Development Model (ADM) principles.

Primary Responsibilities

- Support WAHA's player development objectives and ensure alignment with ADM guidelines.
- Collaborate with fellow Team Wyoming coaches and directors to deliver consistent, age-appropriate training.
- Create a positive, competitive environment that prioritizes development, teamwork, and respect.
- Attend all scheduled Team Wyoming development weekends and tournaments.
- Participate in the Wyoming Player Development Camp including on-ice coaching and/or player evaluation for team selections.
- Communicate effectively with players, parents, and WAHA leadership.
- Contribute to player evaluations and feedback processes when appropriate.

2026-27 Team Wyoming Season:

- **April** - Player Development Camp in Casper
 - Boys PDC: Apr. 9-12, 2026
 - Girls PDC: Apr. 16-19, 2026
- **May - August:** Practice & Scrimmages
 - 3-4 Practice weekends (approx. 1 per month)
 - 1-2 Scrimmage weekend (can be combined with practice weekends)
- **September - March:** Tournaments
 - Approx 1-2 Tournament weekend per month, predominantly on holiday weekends (Thanksgiving, New Years, MLK, Presidents Day).
 - Example schedule based on previous seasons:
 - *September*: Mid September-Showcase (AA teams)
 - *October*: SilverSticks (AA teams); Halloween (A teams)
 - *November*: Thanksgiving Weekend
 - *December*: New Years
 - *January*: MLK Weekend
 - NAPHL Show Series (Boys AA teams) Oct, Nov, Jan.
 - *February*: Presidents Day Weekend
 - *March*: Nationals Prep Weekend (AA teams)
 - *March/April*: -Nationals (AA teams)
 - NWAHL League(16UAA&18UAA)-Sept/Oct & holiday weekends
