



Wyoming Amateur Hockey Association (WAHA) Girls Player Development Director

Duties and Responsibilities

It will be the responsibility of the WAHA Girls Player Development Director to supervise the development program of WAHA, including working directly with all WAHA associations to improve player development within Wyoming. The WAHA Girls Player Development Director will act as a liaison and advisor to all WAHA girls player development officials around the state. The WAHA Girls Player Development Director duties will include assisting with training of local programs and others within WAHA and serving as the affiliate's initial contact for people with questions regarding player development in their local association. The WAHA Girls Player Development Director will also share information from USA Hockey and the Northern Plains District to the other associations within WAHA. The WAHA Girls Player Development Director will be responsible for administering the WAHA evaluation process and the selection of WAHA players to any Northern Plains District and USA Hockey camps or events.

The WAHA Girls Player Development Director will report to the WAHA President and the WAHA Player Development and Team Wyoming Committees.

WAHA Player Development Camps

WAHA Player Development Camps are held each year following the conclusion of the WAHA hockey season. The objective of the WAHA Player Development Camps is to provide players around the state an affordable post-season hockey camp with the best available coaches. The camps focus on building and continuing to develop the fundamental hockey skills (skating, passing, shooting, etc.). There are no limitations on skill ability and all players registered with USA Hockey are encouraged to attend. At the conclusion of the camps, some players may be selected to advance to the Northern Plains District Player Development Camps. If this is the case, players will be selected at the WAHA Player Development Camps and notified post-camp by a WAHA and/or district representative. There may also be other opportunities available such as multi-district and regional USA Hockey camps or events. WAHA Player Development Camps are coordinated by the WAHA Youth and Girls Player Development Directors.

Team Wyoming

In conjunction with supervising the girls development program of WAHA, the WAHA Girls Player Development Director will oversee Team Wyoming tryouts. This will include coordinating the evaluation and selection process, along with helping build the on and off-ice programming for Team Wyoming tryouts. Additional guidance and consultation will occur between the WAHA President and WAHA Player Development and Team Wyoming Committees.
