

Becoming a Sculling Mentor:

In order to become a Sculling Mentor a sculler must be an independent sculler for **at least three (3) months and have at least 15 sculling outings**. It is recommended that the *Prospective Sculling Mentor* review the Sculling Mentoring Guidelines/Best Practices document and talk to current Sculling Mentors to understand what is expected of Sculling Mentors.

Upon meeting the requirements, the process to become approved as a *Sculling Mentor* is as follows:

1. The Prospective Sculling Mentor shall contact the Director in charge of Sculling at Sculling@WesternReserveRowing.com, to express their interest in becoming a Sculling Mentor.
2. The Director in charge of Sculling will coordinate a time for the Prospective Sculling Mentor to row with an Experienced Mentor and a newer sculler. During the row the Experienced Mentor will observe and evaluate the Prospective Sculling Mentor as he/she mentors the newer sculler.
3. The Experienced Mentor will offer their recommendations on the Prospective Sculling Mentor, to the sculling committee for approval.
4. The Director in charge of Sculling will then notify the *Prospective Sculling Mentor* whether they have been approved to become a Sculling Mentor.
