



# ENFIELD RAMBLERS FOOTBALL & CHEER

## Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

All players, parents/guardians, board members, volunteers and coaches are expected to conduct themselves in a manner so that they fully represent the Enfield Ramblers Football & Cheer programs in a positive light. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be accepted from anyone in the Enfield Ramblers organization.

### Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct:

- I will assist the Ramblers in teaching my child and others in the organization that rules are important and should be followed.
- I understand that children learn best by example. I will be a positive role model and help to teach good sportsmanship in victory and defeat.
- I will conduct myself in a civil and respectable manner at all organization sponsored events.
- I will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct, foul language, physical confrontations or harassment of any official, coach, player or parent including in person, via phone/text or on social media (i.e. Facebook, Snapchat, etc.)
- I will ensure that my athlete is on time for practices and games. I will let the coaches know as far in advance as possible if a practice or game will be missed.
  - I understand for the safety of my athlete and their teammates if one practice is missed during the week leading up to a game, my athlete will not play/cheer the 1st quarter of the game, two missed practices will result in the player not playing/cheering in the 1st half of the game. If all practices are missed during the week leading up to a game, my athlete will not be able to participate at the game. (If all practices for the week are missed and the player can not participate in the weekly game, they are still encouraged to come and cheer on their teammates.)
  - I understand that for the safety of all cheerleaders, the two weeks before competition are mandatory practices. If any practices are missed this will result in the cheerleader being unable to participate in the cheer competition.
- I will remain at the field at all times for my player that is on the Mighty Mite or C football team for each practice and game, in case of emergency or for any disciplinary actions that may arise.
- I understand that smoking, drinking of alcoholic beverages and the use of illegal substances is prohibited at all practices and games.
- I understand that if I am not a respectful fan that my child's right to play for the Enfield Ramblers could be at risk of expulsion for the season.
- I also accept responsibility for my family members, friends, guests and/or anyone who accompanies me to any Ramblers game, practice or Ramblers sponsored event. I will ensure that they exhibit good sportsmanship and comply with this Code of Conduct as well.
- I understand that if an issue or concern arises relating to a game, that I will allow for a 24 hour cooling off period from the time of the incident. After the 24 hour period I will talk to the coaching staff about the incident.
- I understand that if an issue arises during the season, that I will follow the appropriate escalation process. I will inform the coach of the issue, if after that the issue has not been addressed I will escalate the issue to the Football or Cheer Director. If at any point, I do not feel comfortable with the process, I will bring the issue to a Ramblers board member. (board member contact information is on the Enfield Ramblers website). Please remember that we are a volunteer organization, please allow up to 24 hours for your issue to be addressed.
