Uniform Policy 2026-2027 Season

The following provisions apply to participation in hockey programming with Lakes Area Hockey Association (“LAHA”), which includes the Boji Mammoths.

LAHA Travel Uniform Requirements

Squirt, PeeWee, and Bantam:

- Game Jerseys– Only the approved LAHA jerseys are to be worn during games
- Breezers– Black
- Gloves– Black
- Helmets– Black
- Helmet Stickers– Only hockey jersey number on back of helmet and approved Boji Mammoth sticker on side of helmet
- Neck Laceration Protector– Black
- Stick Tape– Black or White
- Skate Laces– White
- Game Socks– All players will wear LAHA approved socks. These are not to be worn during practice

High School:

- Game Jerseys– Only the approved LAHA jerseys are to be worn during games.
- Breezers– Black
- Breezers Covers– Only the approved LAHA Breezer Covers are to be worn during games.
- Gloves– Only the approved LAHA gloves are to be worn during games.
- Helmets– Only the approved LAHA Helmets are to be worn during games.
- Helmet Stickers– Only hockey jersey number on back of helmet and approved Boji Mammoth sticker on side of helmet
- Neck Laceration Protector– Black
- Stick Tape– Black or White
- Skate Laces– White
- Game Socks– All players will wear LAHA approved socks. These are not to be worn during practice

High School Jerseys:

- Individual nameplates or any other decals will not be allowed on the jerseys

LAHA General Jersey & Sock Policy

- Jersey numbers will be administered by LAHA to avoid duplication
- Families are responsible for purchasing their own jerseys and/or socks through the provided order form. Once all orders have been submitted, LAHA will coordinate the distribution of jerseys and socks to the appropriate families.
- Players and parents at all levels are responsible for keeping their jerseys and socks clean and in good repair throughout the season
- LAHA reserves the right to require a jersey and/or sock be repaired or replaced as deemed necessary
