- Last season requirements were \$200 fee plus \$150 fundraising. NO volunteer hours need.

e. House League

- Games will be played every other Tuesday. (To start first Tuesday in Nov)
 - o End of season tournament is a possibility
- Will need to complete volunteer hours and fundraising
- Pricing:

- Possibility for house league teams to participate in the Boji Blast tournament at 6U and 8U level depending on the number of teams registered.
- House league player could join travel if there is space on the roster and done before 12/31.
 May be required to attended an evaluation session with the travel team and must be committed to attending all practices and games. Must cover extra team fees, travel expenses, uniforms and other costs associated with the season.
