



BOJI BLAST MITE JAMBOREE RULES

- USA Hockey rules will govern play
- Players must be registered in their USA Hockey affiliate as Mites
- Coach/Manager for each team must have team ready to start on time. Be ready 10 minutes before game time.
- When possible teams should bring a light and a dark jersey
- Pull-overs may be used so there is a color differential
- Team manager or coach needs to check in at least 60 minutes prior to the first game time
- There will be two officials with one designated for each game going on the ice.
- Penalties assessed by the referee will result in the offending player sitting the remainder of their shift
- Coaches are allowed to call a penalty on their own team
- No timeouts

Mini Mite (6U)

- ½ ice games will be played 4 on 4 with regulation goals & no goalies
- Dividers will be placed on the red line separating ends
- ½ ice games will be played at one time
- Puck will be dropped to start period only
- If a goal is scored the scoring team retreats back to their half to allow defending team a breakout
- **Line changes will be signaled by a horn every 2 minutes with the puck remaining live**
- If a puck leaves play the referee will place a puck where it left and play will resume
- Score will not be kept

Mite (8U)

- ½ ice games will be played 4 on 4 with regulation goals & goalies
- Dividers will be placed on the red line separating ends
- ½ ice games will be played at one time
- Puck will be dropped to start period only
- If a goal is scored the scoring team retreats back to their half to allow defending team a breakout
- **Line changes will be signaled by a horn every 2 minutes with the puck remaining live**
- Teams will switch ends each period
- If a puck leaves play the referee will place a puck where it left and play will resume
- Score will not be kept

Game Times

- Warm up – 2 minutes
- Three 16-minute run time periods with 1 minute rest between periods.
- Horn will sound every two minutes to signal line change. Puck will remain live
- Ice will be resurfaced every 2 games
- Lakes Area Hockey Association, Tournament Directors and all personnel connected with the tournament shall not be held liable for injuries or losses sustained during the tournament.
- NOTICE: Games will be played even in the event of bad weather. No rescheduling date will be made.
- Tournament Director reserves the right to modify this format if games fall behind schedule.
- ***In all other matters not covered above the Tournament Director's Decisions will be final.***
