WHAT IS CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT AND WHY IS IT A GREAT OPPORTUNITY FOR MY HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT?

Concurrent enrollment provides high school students with the opportunity to enroll in post-secondary courses and earn credit at no cost to them for tuition. Colorado data show that students in concurrent enrollment programs are more likely to enroll in post-secondary education, have higher post-secondary grade point averages and retention rates, and have a decreased need for remediation. Currently we have four Summit Academy Sports students doing CE courses online with Front Range College; Pre-Calc, Calculus, Intro to Stats and Business Management.

Concurrently Enrollment for Fall 2025

High School students planning to take CE courses next Fall MUST attend one of the upcoming meetings at the Summit Academy school in Westminster. Attendance is mandatory, for the student AND a parent. The meeting will be offered; Jan 30 or Feb 12 -- both at 3:30pm at Summit Community Room. For the students who are doing CE already, they do not need to come again.




