Program Identity

NH Selects is a full-season hockey program focused on player development, competitive opportunities, and consistent team training. At certain Prep–Tier I Elite levels, split-season options may be offered for specific teams only, as described below.

Full Season vs. Limited Split Season (Prep–Tier I Elite)

NH Selects' default model is full season. However, split-season teams may be offered at the Prep–Tier I Elite level for: (i) 18U Boys and (ii) 19U Girls. If offered, open roster spots will be limited and determined by program needs and roster availability. Interest list/Application process will be available through NH Selects website.

- Skill-based development model (Power Edge Pro / PEP-certified instruction).
- Professional certified coaching staff and video education (chalk talks / Hockey IQ).
- Goalie-specific training (Puckstoppers partnership)
- in-season strength & conditioning programming (Platinum Athletes Partnership).
- Pre-season 4-day development camp (daily on-ice + off-ice) and UNH pre-season tournament participation (where applicable).

Anticipated Season Milestones

- February & March: Tryouts for all non-national bound teams.
- April: Tryouts for National Bound teams.
- May (TBD): Organization kick-off BBQ + equipment swap + fitting + registration clean-up (final paperwork/support).
- Mid-summer (TBD): Target timeline for publishing team schedules (subject to league and facility confirmations).
- Late August / Early September (TBD): UNH Training Camp begins.
- During Training Camp: Parent meetings while players are on-ice to review expectations, communication, and season logistics.
- Player Interviews / Check-ins: Conducted during Training Camp, again prior to Christmas break, and again post-season.

UNH Training Camp + Invite-Only Tournament (Tentative)

- Training Camp format: Monday–Thursday with both on-ice and off-ice components.
- Invite-only tournament held Friday–Sunday following camp conclusion.
- Awards: Winners receives a banner; a perpetual trophy will be retained by NH Selects for division champions and divisional NH Selects MVP of the Tournament.

League Planning & Governance Updates

- Entry into the Premier Hockey League of New England Board of Directors meeting to seek approval to enter the league: 2/10/2026 (pending board approval).
- NH Selects is in the process of converting to non-profit status; the timeline is under final review and approval for 501(c)(3) designation.



Ice Delivery Consistency (Continuous Improvement)

We recognize that last season included some scheduling conflicts impacting ice delivery. NH Selects is addressing this through an updated facility agreement approach intended to improve predictability and reduce disruptions, while acknowledging that facility operations and league scheduling can occasionally require adjustments.
