 - Background & coaching experience
 - Why do you coach?
 - Share your coaching philosophy, goals, and objectives for the season
 - How will you communicate

- **Team Manager**
 - Introduction (if identified or request a parent to volunteer)
 - Responsibilities
 - Schedule/coordinate volunteers to run the penalty box & scoreboard

- **Player Expectations**
 - Team rules
 - Player Code of Conduct (on SFYHA site)
 - Respect all team members, opposing team, officials, coaches, and parents
 - Respect for East Bethel Ice Arena & other facilities
 - Locker room etiquette
 - Time of arrival for games & practices
 - Expectations for practices/games
 - Dress/attire for games/practices.
 - Tournament/hotel expectations

- **Parent Expectations**
 - Locker room policy/rules
 - Locker room monitors
 - Expectations for attending games.
 - Crossbar; game/practice attendance
 - Volunteer to run the penalty box & scoreboard as needed
 - Parent Code of Conduct (on SFYHA site)
 - 24-hour rule
 - Parents should not yell at officials, opposing players or coaches
 - Applaud all players efforts
 - SFYHA is to be represented positively at tournaments/games
