3) Meeting Minutes Review. December approve no opposition.

4) Treasurer's Report

- Current Status
 - Sunflower \$45,958.94
 - Ent \$53,854.40
 - Savings at ent \$40,845
 - Total \$140,618.42
 - Have not seen Feb bill and remaining of January to see if we got the ice credit
 - EPQP still needs paid
 - 1 active delinquent player. Emails have been sent to player to let them know the status. CAHA wants to see a deadline to pay by or they would be placed on the list
 - Becky will get the billing for dryland done
 - CRHL sent team fees \$1800 (3 teams at 400 league fee is 600) and should expect RMHF soon

5) Organization Updates

- CAHA Update
 - Announce state play off format 6 teams with 4 auto bids, 2 teams that make playoffs at platinum divisions (assuming they do the same divisions as last year)
 - Caha is looking at starting May 1 to July 1 for registration for returning players and cannot transfer until after July 1 which will move up evaluation windows in May or June, this IS NOT solidified but will be soon. There was a clarification made on dual rostered players for play off eligibility if they play more than 6 games at a higher level.
- RMHF League
 - Brad suspects breaking up the bracket on their end for playoffs.
- CRHL League
 - Just got a new president

6) Director of Tournaments

- Updates
 - All teams have been registered for centennial cup or state, they will do state if they make it but have back up of centennial cup. If teams make state there will be a refund for the centennial cup (12uA, 12u rec, and 10ub are waitlisted) – association voted via text to pay for all teams to pay for this if teams choose to play in those.
 - Casper doesn't have a sanction number so cannot do travel permit for 12uA team for John Wold tournament, once that comes out we can do the travel permit which takes about a week
 - Jamboree update: 7 teams beginner, 12 teams intermediate (1 of each of our teams) work around public sessions on Friday and Sat, and need to be done by 445 on Sunday and have been confirmed with Daphne. Toms Travel and Red Eye vendors confirmed will need schedule when it comes out. Tara historically tried to do Sat and Sunday only. Fridays are tried to be avoided. Tara will send the tournament logo to Brittany

7) VP and Director of Coaches

- Updates
 - Brad talked to Dave and Jerry and they want Brad to be involved with the picking of Director of Coaches, they have a couple people in mind and check with them before committing them. VP and Director of Coaches are not voted on by membership, but appointed by the Junior Bulls and have to be apart of their organization

8) Misc Items

- Put New Board Members in Office
 - Abe Armendariz to the Secretary position
 - Matthew Grable to Director of Tournaments
- Spring Hockey
 - We have had a few submissions for the logo and name suggestions
 - Brad has been talking to Springs to make sure we don't do our tryouts at the same time as Springs. Mike Greene will update for that date with Brad, and likely to be middle of March
 - About \$600 a player will be solidified at a later date
 - Jerseys will likely be provided by the association and used every year
- Try Hockey for Free March 7th 3pm-4pm confirmed. Monument has offered to give helmets
- Storage Inventory – date needs to be redetermined and set, working on ways to use the gear that is in the locker
- Restrunging Nets – intermediate nets need done and materials need to be ordered for at least 5

- End of Year Celebration – usually done in April or May, board will work on that later – patches will be handed out then
- Summer Hockey Events/Camps – working to keep enough events available for the youth association
- Dryland Options for 2026-2027 will look at long term solutions later
- Remind team managers to submit their patches for their players
- Mile High Mites – D70 will potentially send out for us
- Bob Gregorich said there is a team coming from Mexico City to the Pres tournament and would like to scrimmage 10uB asking about ice time – Brad will work with Daphne and Heather to work this out.
- Brad also talking to Jerry and Marty and opening of a youth spirit store through the youth organization and both Juniors and Youth will both benefit – logistics will be talked about later
