8U Stampede Jamboree Rules

February 20th - February 21st

CREDENTIALS CHECK AND QUALIFICATIONS

1. All teams, players, coaches must be registered with USA Hockey
2. All players must adhere to proper protective equipment.
3. **NECK GUARDS ARE REQUIRED-NO EXCEPTIONS.**
 - Neck guards are mandatory for all youth, girls, high school and adaptive players per USAH rules. Hockey Canada players must wear throat protectors.
4. Teams are required to check in one hour prior to their first scheduled game.
5. Official USA Hockey Certified 1-T roster for the 2026-2027 season, signed by associate registrar.
 - **Must be received by the tournament director no later than 2 weeks prior to the tournament.**

7. Rosters must include the following: Players, All Coaches, and Team Managers.

FEES AND REGISTRATION

8. Non-refundable entry fee due upon team registration no later than February 2nd, 2027.
 - **Beginner**
 - \$600 for teams registered on or before January 1st 2027
 - \$650 for teams registered after January 1st 2027
 - 10–12 teams allowed
 - **Intermediate**
 - \$650 for teams registered on or before January 1st 2027
 - \$700 for teams registered after January 1st 2027
 - 10–12 teams allowed

***Registration closes on February 1st 2027**

9. There will be no admission fee for spectators.
10. Teams will be notified of acceptance upon review of application.
11. If your team is not accepted, the entry fee will be refunded.

GAME FORMAT

12. This is a USAH sanctioned Jamboree. All players and teams must be properly registered with USA Hockey.
13. Current USA Hockey ADM league rules shall govern hockey play.
14. All games will be officiated by registered USA Hockey coaches, 1 per team on ice.
15. Games will count towards the maximum allowed per ADM policies.

16. Game scores will not be kept or posted on ESS.
17. Teams should arrive at the rink at least one hour prior to their game and be ready to play 10 minutes prior to their scheduled game time.
18. Mite Jamboree: 8U Mites, co-ed. Divisions: beginner, intermediate
 - Beginner Division: Guaranteed (6) 24-minute, runtime, 4v4 cross ice games, mini nets, no goalies, and no score kept.
 - Intermediate Division: Guaranteed (6) 24-minute, runtime, 4v4 half ice games, intermediate nets with goalies, no score kept.
19. All games played with blue pucks supplied by Pueblo Bulls Youth Hockey; warm up pucks need to be supplied by their own team.
20. Pueblo Bulls Youth Hockey to provide clock personnel to manage time.
21. A buzzer will sound every 2 minutes to signal line changes.
22. Jamboree games have no penalties, no overtime, and no championship games.
23. The goal of our Jamboree is to promote the fun of ice hockey, good sportsmanship, teamwork, and fair play.

LOCKER ROOMS

24. Locker room assignments can be found in the lobby of the rink.
25. All teams will be responsible for cleaning up the locker room and leaving it in excellent condition upon leaving.
26. Pueblo Ice Arena or its staff nor Pueblo Bulls Youth Hockey Association will assume any responsibility for the loss/theft/damage to any personal property left in the locker rooms or the arena grounds, including parking lots.

JERSEYS

27. All players must wear a numbered jersey in the proper team color. If there are home and away jerseys for the team, bring both sets of jerseys to each game.

FORFEITS/REFUSAL TO PLAY

28. Forfeit policy states that any team which enters a tournament and fails to appear on time for a scheduled game or any team (CAHA registered or otherwise) who fails to provide a valid T-1 roster to the Tournament Director prior to the first game of the tournament will be subject to:
 - Forfeit all tournament games as determined by the Tournament Director.
 - Pay for all expenses, including but not limited to referee fees and ice costs, for each forfeited game.
 - Denied entry in any Colorado tournament for the remainder of the season and in the case of a CAHA team, any approved travel permits will be rescinded.
 - Refusal to play policy states that any team refusing to play under any circumstances forfeits the game(s) as well as their entry fee.

SAFE SPORT COMPLIANCE

29. The USAH Sanctioned Tournament Safe Sport Program Protocol will be adhered to.
