Tournament Director

- Apparel conversation -Brittany would like to pursue options on jackets for 10/12/14 and hoodies for 8U. Potentially offering pants as an option. Also spoke of reversible practice jerseys possibly with players numbers on the backs.
- 8U Jamboree conversation - Brittany would like to work on potential February 8U jamboree dates as soon as the Junior team schedule for next season is released.

Old Business

- USA CAHA RMHF update- USA hockey rule changes may affect residency rules for the upcoming season. CAHA has changed registration dates and our registration will open

May 1, this will give the option of adding months to payment plans and may help families with budgeting for the season. Try out dates have not been solidified but likely will fall into August for 14U, September for 12U and 10U. RMHF has no news to report.

- 279 Lab program implementation update- President will be working on ice availability to get the program out to only participants from last year at no cost to the participants, it was referenced that there may be a “No Show” fee of \$25 dollars for each missed day by registrants. Total on ice time 5 hours.
- Try Goalie event discussion- Goalie coach from last season will be paid for 5 hours of goalie training at no cost to participants.

The cost to the association is detailed below:

-279 Lab Coaching Fee	\$1,500 (total for 2 coaches)
-Ice Cost, including ice make	\$4,700 (18.75 total hours, including ice make. 10 hours for 279 lab and 5 hours for goalies, 3.75 hours for ice make)
-Goalie Coaching Fee	\$ 750 (5, 1 hour sessions at \$150/hr)
-Total Estimated Cost	\$6,950

- 3v3 program discussion- As the Ice Arena is not clear when ice will be melted and remade for the season this item was tabled for the next meeting as it would like to be closer in time to tryout dates.
- Summer program registration and team formation update- Registration requires 11 skaters and one goaltender. Registered participants are 14 for 10U, 8 for 12U and 8 for 14U. The board President and Bob Gregorich will be contacting members to attempt to reach the registration requirement numbers in the upcoming days to get the 12 and 14 to participation minimums.

- Minnequa Works Credit Union donation (\$3,300 goal-based fundraiser) Junior team had 165 goals on the season, each goal Minnequa donated \$20 to PBYHA.
