To uphold the highest standards of sportsmanship and to establish the Dayton Hockey Association as a leading example in Southwest Ohio youth hockey both on and off the ice, Dayton Hockey Association reserves the right to refuse or return any registration for participation in its programs if the Executive Board determines that said registration would undermine the organization's goals, mission, or programming.

This decision may be based on the past or present conduct of the individual seeking to register or has registered, or any member of their immediate or extended family, former spouses, and individuals within their social networks. If an individual or related party's prior conduct has been subject to disciplinary action by USA Hockey, any USA Hockey-affiliated organization or entity, law enforcement agencies, or the management of the rinks utilized by Dayton Hockey Association, or if the Executive Board deems their conduct otherwise contrary to the best interests of the organization or its programs, the Dayton Hockey Association reserves the right to deny or return registration.
