



COACH AND ON-ICE HELPER DIGITAL WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

Dayton Hockey Association Coach and On-Ice Helper Waiver and Release of Liability

This Waiver and Release of Liability ("Waiver") is entered into by the undersigned coach ("Coach") in favor of the Dayton Hockey Association ("DHA"), its officers, directors, agents, volunteers, and employees.

1. Acknowledgment of Risk:

The Coach acknowledges and understands that participation in hockey activities, including but not limited to coaching, training, and all related events and activities, carries inherent risks of personal injury, including serious injury, disability, or death. The Coach voluntarily assumes all such risks associated with participation.

2. Release of Liability:

In consideration of being permitted to participate in hockey activities under the auspices of the Dayton Hockey Association, the Coach agrees to release, hold harmless, and indemnify the DHA, its officers, directors, agents, employees, and volunteers from any and all claims, liabilities, demands, or causes of action, including but not limited to those arising from personal injury, property damage, or death, that may occur during participation in any hockey activities, whether caused by the negligence of the DHA or otherwise.

3. USA Hockey Claims Process:

The Coach acknowledges that any claims related to personal injury or other injuries sustained during participation in hockey activities must be made through USA Hockey's official claims process. The Coach agrees to abide by USA Hockey's rules, policies, and procedures for filing claims related to injuries.

4. Medical Insurance:

The Coach is advised to carry appropriate medical insurance to cover any potential medical expenses arising from injuries sustained during hockey activities. The DHA does not provide medical insurance coverage for coaches or participants.

5. Governing Law:

This Waiver shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Ohio.

6. Severability:

If any provision of this Waiver is found to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

By accepting the terms of this document during Coach and On-Ice Helper registration, the registrant acknowledges that they have read and understood this Waiver and voluntarily agree to the terms set forth herein.
