Member / Parent Code of Conduct

As a member of HYHA, I understand the importance of embracing the values of good sportsmanship while demonstrating fairness, respect, and self-control by supporting all players, coaches, team managers, referees, fans, and parents.

- I am a representative of HYHA in my conduct and behavior in the community. I will contribute to a positive organizational and community culture at, before, and after hockey and team events.
- I will respect the coaches and refrain from questioning or confronting coaches during or immediately after a game or practice. If I have questions or issues, I will contact the coach with a request to discuss.
- I will respect the officials and refrain from questioning or confronting officials before, during, or after a game.
- I will not yell at any referees, coaches, players, or fan sections.
- I will respect the locker rooms as private areas for players, coaches, managers, and officials and will seek approval before entering.
- In all HYHA activities, I will refrain from abusive, obscene, or threatening language or gestures, physical violence, and any unsportsmanlike or disrespectful behavior.
- I will not endanger the health, safety, or well-being of any coach, parent/guardian, player, participant, employee, official, or any other attendee.
- My actions are subject to the USA and MN Hockey Rules, HYHA Codes of Conduct, and District 3 Guidelines. I understand that ignorance to or misunderstanding of a rule or standard on my part is not a defense to a charge of misconduct.
- It is my responsibility to respect all equipment, supplies, and facilities (for parents/guardians: I will ensure that my child does the same).
- I am required to perform volunteer duties during the season, including but not limited to concessions, clock, scoreboard, gamesheet, and penalty box. I will take available training to learn these roles. Lack of training does not excuse any missed volunteer hours.

Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action including but not limited to a verbal or written warning, game or season suspension, or permanent expulsion. Suspensions and expulsions will not result in refunded fees.
