June 10th, 2026

Meeting called to order at 6:04

- **Attendance-** Joel Abar, Ryan Bouchey, Todd Demers, Austie Jerome, Grace Montana, Allyse Pierce, Erik Whitcombe
- **Acceptance of May's meeting minutes-** Motion to accept minutes by Joel, 2nd by Erik~ All in favor.
- **Treasurer's Report-** \$18,592.22 in account- this includes some registrations for the upcoming season. \$100 for plaque from the Hazen & Ice slot of \$200 are still waiting to be withdrawn.
- **Correspondence** - None
- **Coach's Meeting** -Steve Lemieux and Kelson Hooper attended the meeting to discuss expectations and plans for the upcoming season.
- **Registration Update-** 9 players registered to date.
 - Registration will be activated following tonight's meeting, and advertising efforts will begin.
 - Intro, 6U, 8U, 10U, 12U House, 12U TB, 14U, 16U will be offered this season. (12U TB team already completed from tryouts)
 - The board plans to distribute flyers to local schools promoting OMHA & emphasizing that full equipment is available for players who need it.
 - The board discussed establishing a new scholarship to assist families who may need help covering registration costs.
 - The Barr family has offered to sponsor this new scholarship in place of their previous Hazen scholarship. The scholarship will now be awarded through OMHA's annual tournament.
 - Motion to approve new scholarship made by Ryan, second Joel~ All in favor.
- **Jersey/Warm up Updates-**Todd spoke with Thomas at Synergy, he is prepared to open an online store whenever needed for apparel with OMHA's logo
- The board agreed not to take business away from QT Laser, which has provided OMHA apparel for many years. QT will continue producing OMHA's traditional apparel, while Synergy will be considered for warm-up apparel.
 - Grace will speak with Misty about apparel sales & determine when to open an online store.Todd will talk to Thomas about warm up examples.
- **Pictures for next season** - Maria Weston Garvey previously contacted the board about providing team pictures again for the 2026-2027 season.
 - Allyse will reach out to have Maria to do pictures for the 26-27 season.
- **USA Hockey Registration, background screen, safesport for all board members**

- All board members need to complete these tasks, but may not renew SafeSport until their current certification expires.
- **Finalize Fundraising**
 - Chuck a puck, 50/50, raffle baskets can be done by each team at home games and will get 100% of the profit. Any additional fundraising activities must receive prior board approval.
 - Ryan will check at Perry's Place to see if we still have an open account for donations of cans and bottles. If we don't he will open one for OMHA.
 - Mini Raffle- changed to \$5 tickets, packets of 12.
 - 1st- \$1,000; 2nd- \$500; 3rd- \$250.
 - Drawing will be at the January Board Meeting.
 - Ask Craig to have tickets ready for first practice at the parent meeting (October.)
 - Start Selling/Advertising Super Raffle
 - Tickets have been printed & distribution will begin following tonight's meeting.
 - Golf Tournament- 1 team signed up as of right now. The board will continue advertising to increase participation.
- **Handbook**
 - **Edit & Finalize** - the following revisions were made and approved.
 - Players will move to their age-appropriate division after completing one year of Intro Hockey.
 - Intro registration in Crossbar will be updated to reflect birth years 2022-2024.
 - The Conduct and Discipline section will be revised to reference SafeSport guidelines and include a direct link.
- **Old/New Business**
 - Ryan is going to determine whether 10U games require electronic game sheets. If so, OMHA will need to purchase an additional Ipad.
 - The secretary will continue using a personal laptop, so no new laptop purchase is necessary at this time.
 - John Shaver approved a donation of \$500 to have Varsity hockey players assist at all Intro practices.
 - Harrison Wart confirmed that OMHA can reserve the entire weekend of December 11-13 for the annual tournament; however, payment is required immediately to secure the ice. Ryan will discuss alternative scheduling/payment options with Harrisons before the board makes a final commitment.
 - 8U half-ice (ice time permitting,) 10U, 12U, 12U TB will all be divisions included in the tournament.
 - Tournament entry fee will be \$1,000 per team.
