2. Monthly Reports

1. Secretaries Report – John Scholla makes a motion to approve the January minutes as presented in the email that was sent out. Seconded by Amanda Kuhn. Motion passes.
2. Treasurer's Report – Melissa Carey motions to approve the financial report as presented in the email that was sent out prior to the meeting. Seconded by Tina Montoya. Motion passes.
3. Gambling Report/Expenses – Tina Montoya motions to approve \$63,119.71, for January expenses. Seconded by Melissa Carey. Motion Passes
4. Tina Montoya motions to approve up to \$76,000.00 for the month of February gambling expenses. Seconded by Melissa Carey. Motion passes
5. District 8 Report – Cody Fries
 1. Squirt 35 Game Limit
 1. If a Squirt team exceeds 35 games before the District playoffs, they will receive a \$250 fine for every game after 35. Then they will receive a \$250 fine for every District playoff game. They will not be disqualified from the playoffs though. There are no fines if you haven't exceeded 35 games in the regular season going into playoffs.
 2. Timeouts during District playoffs
 1. Timeouts are only permitted for AA/A/B1 for Bantam, PeeWee, 15U, and 12U.

2. Timeouts are not permitted for B2/C in those levels, and are not permitted for any Squirt levels.
3. Refs for Mite games
 1. We should be bringing on level 1 refs for all Mite full ice games. This helps get them more experience. Though not required if labeling as Scrimmages or Coach-led scrimmages, these kids do a lot for us during the season and it's good for their growth.
4. MN Hockey is looking at utilizing smaller nets in Squirt and 10U levels. This has been looked into before, but it's getting more attention and could come as soon as next year.
