- o Tournaments we have started to charge for team tournaments on Crossbar. If anyone has any questions or concerns please let me know.
- Please make sure your family participation, Rules & Ethics, tournament policy & injury policy are completed in Crossbar.
- o CUHL Seeding round has finished as of yesterday. Seeding rounds are double edged sword Sometimes games are lopsided. While those situations are not fun, it does help the league place those teams accordingly in the regular season. As a rule of thumb, usually a bad seeding round leads to a good season. In the end, what we want to see is our players developing. Development is our ultimate goal.

- o We received our 1st Check from SquadLocker last month for \$127.98 WE have sold \$6033.47 in total sales year to date.
- I will continue to refresh and update items for purchase on squadlocker. If there are additional items of interest please reach out to me so they can be added to the website.
- o Now that we have completed both our bulk order and online store we will be able to use the money toward club purchases; ie development & coaches equipment. Please see me for additional questions.
- O Cemino's at the Park I had a conversation with Mark @ Cemino's about their interest in working with us. They are excited to partner with us this fall season. The camera above the West scoreboard is being set up to broadcast and stream practices and games inside Inwood. The park district is actively working on setting that up.
- o Cemino's also interested in setting up a "Mug Club" for alcohol discounts. More on that once available.
- Cemino's is also interested in staffing around our game schedule, if we can provide them with an Inwood game schedule they can make sure they have adequate amount of staff available for our games

- On Ice Music we had a wireless dongle that was being stored with the game clock that has gone missing. o NIHL

- Remember 5 Game suspension there has been a spike in racial slurs

- Numbers are down for refs still
- Managers must get scores recorded in NIHL immediately, there is a \$300 fine that will be the managers responsibility, and the team will take a loss for the game.
- Saturday Nov 2, the brackets will be posted on the NIHL website. Kristin will be sending out your home slots, please create a signup genius for those games. Once you have your bracket, look to see who is coming to you and email those managers. You will find their contact information in the NIHL portal. Ice Scheduler

- There have been quite a few games rescheduled this year across all 3 leagues. Great job to the managers of those teams who almost all had to deal with difficult negotiations & the managers of opposing teams overcomplicating things that would be simple. You were confident & prepared to advocate for the right thing & that helps so much.
- The practice schedule is done though 11/8. Please keep in mind with things like game reschedules & emergency situations (Like broken zamboni), that the schedule is always fluid.
- o As we roll into November & the holiday's, our ice gets a little light because of rink blackouts. Teams in the weekend tourney are prioritized over other teams, so there are times you may only see 1 practice for the week.
- o That said, if something looks off for your team please just ask! There is a method to the madness but I'm human & occasionally make mistakes.
- After some negotiation with Canlan, you will notice our Wednesdays are currently 30 min earlier & on Rink 2 instead of 3. This will continue until 12/18 & will be determined then if it can continue for the remainder of the season. This change is pending their YHL registrations
- o CUHL regular season scheduling will begin tomorrow 10/22 & is being done via grid like we did for seeding. Mite managWHL regular season scheduling will be Sunday 11/17 @ 10:30 AM in Franklin Park.
- o Managers, talk with your coaches & confirm blackout dates & tournament plans if you still haven't finished registering for those. I can only work with the information I'm given, so please keep that line of communication open with me. If your roster is on the lighter end, ask families if they have travel plans for holidays or school/religious events that may impact your bench for a game. Knowing that info ahead of time avoids last minute game rescheduling
- o On that note, consider the home location of your opponents in your divisions. The deeper into January & February we get, the more likely it is that you or your opponent will be driving during snow events. If you can negotiate games that require long distance travel to earlier in the season that will reduce chances of rescheduling.
- o Jaguar Memorial Game Day is Saturday 1/4/25. Teams given a home ice slot that weekend need to move mountains to make sure those get filled. This is a very important event for the club & Jaguar Alumni.
