Chicago United Hockey League (CUHL) – Mite Travel

Our Mite Travel teams compete in the Chicago United Hockey League (CUHL) from September through March. The season includes a full schedule of full-ice league games and concludes with round-robin playoffs.

In addition to league play, Mite Travel teams will participate in multiple tournaments throughout the season.

Practices and home games are held at Inwood Ice Arena, CANLAN Ice Sports – Romeoville, and Rocket Ice Arena.

Squirt–Midget Travel

Our Squirt through Midget travel teams compete in one of two leagues based on team placement:

- **Central States Development Hockey League (CSDHL)**
- **Northwest Hockey League (NWHL)**

The season includes league play, tournaments, and postseason opportunities.

Practices and home games are held at Inwood Ice Arena, CANLAN Ice Sports – Romeoville, and Rocket Ice Arena.

Lady Jaguars Girls Hockey

For the 2026–2027 season, the Lady Jaguars will field an all-girls team at the 10U/12U level. The team will compete in the Northern Illinois Hockey League (NIHL) Girls Division, providing players with the opportunity to develop and compete against girls' teams from across the Chicagoland area.

Practices and home games will be held at Inwood Ice Arena, CANLAN Ice Sports – Romeoville, and Rocket Ice Arena.

Team Selection

Teams are selected based on player skill level. Depending on registration numbers, Jaguar Hockey Club will field both **birth-year** and **combined birth-year** teams.

While we strive to place every player on a team, placement on a specific team or in a particular league is not guaranteed. Players will be placed on the team that best supports both their current ability and long-term development.

Ice Schedule

- Jaguar Hockey Club understands that tournaments, special events, and other rink scheduling conflicts at **Inwood Ice Arena**, **CANLAN Ice Sports**, and **Rocket Ice Arena** may occasionally affect our weekly ice schedule. These factors have been considered when establishing player fees, and teams may receive additional ice throughout the season as it becomes available.
- While we are committed to providing the proposed ice schedule, it is subject to change based on factors including, but not limited to, the number of teams.

Goalie Clinics

Jaguar Hockey Club offers weekly goalie clinics led by experienced instructors to supplement team practices and support goalie development throughout the season.

These dedicated sessions provide goalies with specialized instruction to complement their team practices and help build the skills and confidence needed to succeed in game play.

Social Media Policy

Jaguar Hockey Club is committed to providing a safe, positive, and respectful environment for all players, families, coaches, volunteers, and staff. We expect all members to conduct themselves appropriately on social media and other online platforms, recognizing that online behavior reflects on both the individual and the club.

As a condition of membership, all players, parents, guardians, coaches, and volunteers are expected to comply with this policy.

Social media includes, but is not limited to, Facebook, Instagram, X (formerly Twitter), Snapchat, TikTok, LinkedIn, blogs, online forums, message boards, and any other digital communication platform.

Members shall not post or share content that:

- Disparages or damages the reputation of Jaguar Hockey Club, its members, coaches, volunteers, or staff.
- Contains abusive, threatening, harassing, vulgar, or offensive language directed toward any individual or organization.
- Targets officials, opposing teams, leagues, or other youth hockey organizations in a disrespectful or derogatory manner.
- Shares confidential or private information about players, families, coaches, volunteers, or club business without permission.
- Interferes with the positive development and experience of players within Jaguar Hockey Club or the youth hockey community.

Members are encouraged to use good judgment and remember that anything posted online may become public and permanent.

Alleged violations of this policy will be reviewed by the Jaguar Hockey Club Rules & Ethics Committee. Reports must be submitted through the club's Incident Action process and include supporting documentation when available.

Depending on the severity of the violation, disciplinary action may include:

- Written warning
- Written apology

- Removal of the offending post(s)
- Suspension from games or club activities
- Removal from Jaguar Hockey Club, with forfeiture of applicable fees

We ask all members to represent Jaguar Hockey Club with integrity, respect, and sportsmanship both on and off the ice.

Equipment & Uniform Policy

Jerseys

Players may **reuse their current Jaguar jerseys** or purchase a new set for the upcoming season. New jersey orders will be placed through **JOG Athletics** at the beginning of the season. Additional orders placed after the initial team order may be subject to production and shipping delays. Requests for replacement or additional jerseys should be directed to the **Equipment Manager**.

Refunds for jersey purchases will only be provided to players who are **not offered a roster spot** within Jaguar Hockey Club.

Helmets & Shells

- **Mite through Bantam:** Black helmets are required.
- **Midget:** Purple helmets & shells are required.

Warm-Ups

Each player will receive a Jaguar Hockey Club warm-up suit, which is **included in the team fees**. Players are expected to wear their warm-ups to all games and team functions unless otherwise instructed by their coach or team manager.

Jersey Numbers

Jaguar Hockey Club maintains a club-wide jersey numbering system to minimize conflicts.

- Returning players will retain their jersey number whenever possible.
- In the event of a number conflict, priority will be given to the player with the **longest consecutive tenure** in Jaguar Hockey Club.

- If two or more players with the same number are placed on the same team, the player with less club tenure will be assigned a new number and may be responsible for the cost of replacement jerseys.
- New players, including Mites, will be assigned an available jersey number based on the club's existing numbering system.
- Requests for specific jersey numbers may not be accommodated. All jersey numbers are assigned by the **Equipment Manager** or **Club President**.

Questions

Questions regarding equipment, uniforms, or jersey orders should be directed to the **Equipment Manager**. Once teams have been finalized, uniform-related questions should be directed to your **Team Manager**.

Jaguar Hockey Club Logo Policy

The Jaguar Hockey Club logo and branding are the exclusive property of Jaguar Hockey Club and are intended to represent the organization in a consistent and professional manner.

Approved Use

The Jaguar Hockey Club logo may only be used for official club purposes, including team apparel, promotional materials, fundraising initiatives, and approved sponsor partnerships.

Apparel & Merchandise

Club logos may not be reproduced, altered, or placed on apparel, equipment, or merchandise without prior approval from the Jaguar Hockey Club Executive Board or its designated representative. This includes custom clothing, decals, banners, signs, and promotional items.

Logo Modifications

The Jaguar Hockey Club logo may not be:

- Altered, redrawn, or modified in any way.
- Stretched, distorted, or recolored.
- Combined with other logos or graphics without approval.
- Used in a manner that could misrepresent or negatively impact the club.

Team Fundraising & Sponsorship

Teams wishing to produce custom apparel or promotional items using the Jaguar Hockey Club name or logo must receive approval before placing an order. This ensures consistency in branding and prevents duplication of existing club merchandise.

Social Media & Marketing

Members are encouraged to promote Jaguar Hockey Club in a positive manner. The club logo may be used on personal social media to support club activities; however, it may not be used to endorse personal businesses, political causes, or any content that conflicts with the values of Jaguar Hockey Club.

Questions

Requests regarding logo usage, custom apparel, merchandise, or branding should be directed to the Jaguar Hockey Club Executive Board before production or publication.

Injury Policy

The health and safety of our players is the Jaguar Hockey Club's highest priority. In the event of a hockey-related injury, the following policy will apply:

Injury Reporting

If a player sustains an injury or suspected concussion that requires them to leave the ice, bench, or facility to seek medical attention:

- The Team Manager must notify the Jaguar Hockey Club Registrar and complete the club's online injury report.
- Before returning to any Jaguar Hockey Club practice or game, the player must provide a written medical release from a licensed healthcare provider. The release should be submitted to the player's Team Manager and Head Coach.
- For any concussion or suspected concussion, the USA Hockey Return-to-Play/Concussion Form must be completed and signed by the treating physician, parent/guardian, and coach before the player may return to on-ice activities.
- Players are not permitted to participate in games or practices while wearing any type of hard cast or rigid splint, regardless of whether they have been medically cleared for contact.
- This policy does not apply to absences related to communicable illness or other club health policies.

Jaguar Hockey Club reserves the right to remove any player from participation if an injury is suspected. Coaches may also require a player to seek medical evaluation and provide written medical clearance before returning to play, even if the player did not leave the ice during a practice or game. Player safety will always take precedence over participation. Jaguar Hockey Club reserves the right to request updated medical documentation if a player's condition changes.

Injury Credits

Players may be eligible for an injury credit under the following conditions:

- The injury occurred during a Jaguar Hockey Club-sponsored practice or game.
- The injury prevents the player from participating for more than six (6) consecutive weeks.

Injuries sustained outside of Jaguar Hockey Club activities are not eligible for an injury credit.

Requests for injury credits and any exceptions or appeals will be reviewed by the Jaguar Hockey Club Board of Directors.

USA Hockey SafeSport Policy

Jaguar Hockey Club is committed to providing a safe, respectful, and positive environment for all players. As an affiliate of **USA Hockey**, Jaguar Hockey Club fully supports and enforces the USA Hockey SafeSport Program.

SafeSport is designed to help prevent abuse, bullying, harassment, hazing, and other forms of misconduct while promoting a culture of safety and respect both on and off the ice.

SafeSport Requirements

- All coaches, team managers, locker room monitors, and other required volunteers must complete **USA Hockey SafeSport Training** and satisfy all USA Hockey screening requirements before participating in club activities.
- **USA Hockey requires all players who are 17 years of age or older on or before December 31 of the current playing season and who are rostered on a team to complete SafeSport Training before they can be added to an official roster and prior to participating in any team activities.**
- Jaguar Hockey Club follows USA Hockey's **Locker Room Policy**, requiring appropriate supervision and restricting unauthorized access to locker rooms.

- All members are expected to conduct themselves with respect, sportsmanship, and integrity at all club events and activities.

Reporting Concerns

Any concerns involving player safety, abuse, bullying, harassment, hazing, or other misconduct should be reported immediately. Reports may be made to the Jaguar Hockey Club SafeSport Coordinator, the Jaguar Hockey Club Executive Board, or directly through the USA Hockey SafeSport reporting process.

Player safety is the responsibility of every member of the Jaguar Hockey Club community.

Refund Policy

All tryout fees, registration fees, and player fees are final and non-refundable.

Tryout Refund Policy

Jaguar Hockey Club conducts tryouts to evaluate players for placement on the team that best supports their development. The following refund policy applies to all tryout registrations:

- No refunds will be issued after a player has participated in the first scheduled tryout session.
- No refunds will be issued to players who are offered and accept a roster position but later choose not to participate with Jaguar Hockey Club.
- No refunds will be issued for jersey or uniform purchases once an order has been placed.
- Players who are not selected for a travel team are not eligible for a refund, unless Jaguar Hockey Club is unable to field a team at that age level. In that event, a full refund of the tryout fee will be issued.

By registering for tryouts, families acknowledge and agree to the terms of this Tryout Refund Policy.

Returned Payment (NSF), Declined Payment & Delinquent Account Policy

Families enrolled with Jaguar Hockey Club are responsible for ensuring that all payments are successfully processed and that valid payment information is maintained throughout the season.

Returned Payments (NSF)

If a payment is returned due to non-sufficient funds (NSF), a closed account, or any other bank-related reason:

- The outstanding balance becomes immediately due.
- The family is responsible for any bank or payment processing fees incurred by Jaguar Hockey Club as a result of the returned payment.
- Future payments may be required in the form of certified funds, cashier's check, or another payment method approved by the club.

Declined Credit or Debit Card Payments

If a scheduled credit or debit card payment is declined for any reason, including insufficient funds, an expired card, or a card issuer decline:

- The family is responsible for updating their payment information immediately.
- Any missed payment must be paid promptly upon notification.
- Failure to resolve a declined payment may result in the player's suspension from practices, games, tournaments, and other club activities until the account is brought current.

Delinquent Accounts

Player accounts must remain in good standing throughout the season. Any account that becomes delinquent is subject to the following actions:

- Suspension from all Jaguar Hockey Club activities until the outstanding balance is paid in full.
- Loss of eligibility to participate in practices, games, tournaments, and other club-sponsored events.
- Referral to the Amateur Hockey Association of Illinois (AHA) for a Financial Suspension, which may prohibit the player from participating with any AHA-affiliated organization until the financial obligation has been satisfied.

- Jaguar Hockey Club reserves the right to withhold player credentials, roster placement, awards, or other club benefits until the account is current.

Any exceptions to this policy must be approved by the Jaguar Hockey Club Executive Board.

Family Multi-Player Discount

Jaguar Hockey Club offers a family discount for households registering multiple children in the Travel Hockey Program.

- Second Child: 20% discount on player fees.
- Third Child and Each Additional Child: 25% discount on player fees.

Exclusions:

- Family discounts do not apply to goalie registrations.
- Family discounts do not apply to the Development Program.
- The discount is applied to the lowest eligible player registration fee and cannot be combined with any other promotional discounts unless approved by the Jaguar Hockey Club Executive Board.

Families with questions regarding eligibility should contact the Jaguar Hockey Club Registrar before registering.

Goalie Fee Policy

Jaguar Hockey Club recognizes the importance of the goaltending position and offers reduced player fees based on the number of rostered goalies at each age level.

- If a team has **one (1) dedicated goalie**, that goalie will receive a **40% discount** off the applicable fall player fees.
- If a team has **two (2) dedicated goalies**, each goalie will pay **50% of the applicable skater registration fee**.
- A player who is rostered as both a **goalie and a skater ("skates out")** is **not eligible** for the goalie discount and will be responsible for the **full skater registration fee**.

Jaguar Hockey Club reserves the right to determine goalie eligibility and apply discounts based on each team's final roster composition. The club also reserves the right to adjust goalie discounts if roster changes occur during the season.

State Tournament Participation

Participation in the **AHAI State Tournament** is determined solely by the Jaguar Hockey Club Hockey Director and coaching staff.

Not every Jaguar Hockey Club team will participate in the AHAI State Tournament. The decision to enter a team is based on what is in the best interest of the team and the club and may take into consideration a variety of factors, including team competitiveness, player development, league standing, scheduling, and overall program objectives.

The decision regarding whether a team will participate in the AHAI State Tournament rests exclusively with the Jaguar Hockey Club Hockey Director and coaching staff. All decisions are final.

Family Participation Contract Volunteer Requirement

The success of our youth hockey program relies heavily on the support and active involvement of all families. To ensure equitable participation and smooth operation of club activities, the following policy outlines the expectations and responsibilities for each family during the season. This policy is enforced on a per-team basis-families with players on multiple teams must fulfill participation requirements for each team individually.

Volunteer Obligations: Each family is required to work a minimum of five (5) volunteer slots per team during the season. These slots consist of essential game operations, including:

- Running the score clock
- Maintaining the score sheet
- Managing the penalty boxes
- Other duties as requested by the team manager

These responsibilities apply to all home games, tournament games, and playoff games, as needed. Volunteer coverage is critical to ensure games run smoothly and remain in compliance with league requirements.

Note: Volunteer duties throughout the season will be divided as evenly as possible among all families. As a result, the total number of required shifts may be higher or lower than five, depending on the number of games and operational needs for each team.

Scheduling: Volunteer slot scheduling will be managed through Crossbar, where families can sign up for open slots throughout the season.

Credit Card Authorization & Fee Assessment

- If volunteer requirements are not fulfilled, your Crossbar account will automatically be charged the fee.
- Fees will be assessed on February 1st to the payment method on file.
- Failure to pay the Fee will result in a hold being placed on your account, and your player(s) will not be allowed on the ice until the past season's debt is settled. Any Fees collected will be transferred to the Jaguar Memorial Fund.

Explanation of Fees

The Fee is assessed based on the number of skaters per family.

Cost:

- \$350 per skater
- Maximum of \$900 per family

The following positions are exempt from the Fee:

- Team Managers
- Head Coach
- Jaguar Board Members

Recordkeeping: All volunteer hours will be logged by the Team Manager. Team Managers must submit completed records to the Treasurer at the end of the season.
