2. Director of Hockey updates

- a. Collaboration with Tier II/Rec associations

- i. Roger to email Tier II organizations letting them know a TC coach is available to drop into their practice.

- b. Spring Hockey Programming

- i. Rocky Mountain District camp is moved to the weekend of May 8-10 in Dallas (traditionally TC tryout weekend). TC Tryouts now May 1-3.

- ii. Spring program will be the month of April, including Finnesota Cup. (1st weekend 8U, 10U, 12U divisions, second weekend older kids)

1. 14U, 16U, and 19U ID camp in the month of April (Tuesday or Wednesday and Saturday)
2. 10U and 12U tourney teams
3. Will do 8U jamboree Saturday morning. (No 8U tourney team)

- a. Jamboree to be co-branded in 3 different Colorado locations.

- b. Ice will be donated, we collect registrations and have TC coaches.

- c. Run a TC information session concurrently.

- d. Targeting Jan 31 for the first Jamboree as a test run. Holly has contact for successful Jamboree ideas
 - iii. Some organizations (Arapahoe) would like TC coaches to visit 14s and 16s during the year.
- c. Summer Hockey Programming
 - i. Karen let Bill Dobbs know we'd like a Tuesday or Wednesday slot for the summer.
 - ii. College Camp June 15-17
 - iii. July 6-8 or July 13-15 for Offensive/Defensive Camp. Work on offense and defense separately in the morning and then skate together in the afternoon
