HOUSE LEAGUE DRAFT RULES

AS ADOPTED 1994

- 1) Two members of the CHA Board shall preside over the draft.
- 2) When possible, a representative of MAHA shall also be in attendance.
- Only the head coaches for each team shall be in attendance. No other representatives are allowed access to the draft.
- 4) Each coach can protect only his/her child from being picked by another team.
- 5) Coaches need to come prepared with ratings of players by age group. (First year/Second year).
- 6) Ratings can be done anyway the coaches agree to. Usually, a three point system is used with one being most skilled. A five point system is acceptable.
- 7) The draft order will be determined by a coin toss. The order will follow this format: 1-2-3-3-2-1, with the exception of two team drafts being: 1-2-2-1.
- 8) Second year players will be drafted first. Drop picking is allowed (picking a 2 rated player while there are still 1's on the board), but a coach may not pick a player rated lower than his protected player without picking his protected player first.
- After the pool of second year players is exhausted, the first year players will be picked using the same format as for second year players.
- 10) Sponsors will be assigned to teams after the completion of the draft with attention being paid to sponsors children or relatives being on the sponsor's team.
- 11) The ONLY consideration for special requests shall be for placement of siblings on the same team. No other requests will be considered.

Play-offs to determine who goes to Playdowns:

If two teams in a division it will be a best of three series. If the winner is decided after two games, the third game will be an exhibition game. This will usually be completed before Christmas.

If three teams in a division it will be a double elimination bracket. A coin flip will determine who gets the first round bye.

All Play-Off games & House League Championships will be played until there is a winner.
