Peoria Rule: CSDHL Prospects Division Only



The Peoria Rule means that certain teams competing at certain levels of the Prospects Division will be required to play their home games at an opposing team's rink if the opposing team does not wish to travel to their home rink. If the Peoria Rule is invoked, the opposing team provides and pays for ice, referees and athletic trainers (if applicable).

- ❖ Prospects RED (all tiers): No Peoria Rule. Play home games at a club's home rink.
- ❖ Prospects WHITE (all tiers, Squirt – Bantam): Peoria Rule (if invoked) for clubs subject to Peoria Rule (see list below).
- ❖ Prospects BLUE (all tiers, Squirt – Bantam): Peoria Rule (if invoked) for clubs subject to Peoria Rule (see list below).

Clubs subject to the Peoria Rule (*if accepted into the Prospects Division*):

Affton, Bloomington, Champaign, Chesterfield Knights, St. Louis Eagles, Highland Hills, Indy Fuel, Kankakee, Kansas City, Littleton, Madison, Omaha, Pekin, Peoria, South Bend, Southern Ice Hawks, Sharks, Shaw Timberwolves, St. Louis Sting/St. Peters, Quad Cities, and any other club designated by the league.

Games between two teams subject to the Peoria Rule will be played at the respective home rinks as designated by declaration games grid and regular season games grid published by the league.

Game Time Rules, Athletic Trainers and Handshake Line

- **What are the time rules for games played in the Prospects Division?** Visit the CSDHL website at <https://www.csdhl.org/> for information on times for periods, penalties, overtime, ice cuts (for Midget level) and referees.
- **Are clubs required to have athletic trainers for home games at the Bantam and Midget levels of the Prospects Division?** Athletic trainers are **required** for the **Midget** level for the **Prospects Division**. Athletic trainers are *strongly encouraged* for the Bantam level in the Prospects Division.
- Coaches should NOT be in handshake line with players.

Playoffs

- **Not all teams will qualify for playoffs.** The number of teams that will qualify for playoffs will depend on the number of teams in a particular level/tier. Last season, either the top 8 or the top 6 teams advanced to playoffs.
- **Playoff schedule and rink location is determined by CSDHL.**

PENALTIES THAT RESULT IN GAME SUSPENSIONS

- Fighting is an automatic (at least 3 game suspension) by CSDHL.
- Coaches are expected to review their scoresheets after each game and note MAJOR penalties.
- If a player receives a penalty which would require them to sit 1 or more games for suspension, do not play the player in the next game -- additional penalties may be assessed by CSDHL if you do.
- If a player receives a penalty in a CSDHL game which would require them to sit 1 or more games for suspension, the suspension MUST be served in a CSDHL game (different than USA Hockey rules).
- For example, if a player has a 1 game suspension from a major penalty in a CSDHL game and the next game is an out-of-town tournament, the player must sit the 1st game in tournament to satisfy USA Hockey rules, but that does not satisfy CSDHL. The player will also be suspended from the next CSDHL game to satisfy CSDHL. If a player gets a 1 game suspension at a tournament, just make sure they sit the next game whatever it is (not additional CSDHL game).

PUCKS FOR WARM-UPS

- The Home Team provides pucks for warm-ups. Should provide 20 pucks.
- If a Team invokes the Peoria Rule, they provide the pucks for warm-ups to the traveling team.
