



Hudson Hockey Uniform Policy

Hudson Hockey Association (HHA) has a standard uniform for ALL travel levels. Development levels will receive separate instructions provided directly to this age group regarding jerseys and uniforms.

Players not conforming to the uniform policy may not be eligible to participate in game play. If questions on this policy please contact the Vice President of Hockey Operations at vpho@hudsonhockey.com.

Equipment Colors Required:

- Helmet – White
- Breezers – Navy
- Gloves – Navy

Jerseys/Socks:

- Players must wear regulation HHA jerseys as issued by the Hudson Hockey Association for all league games (home and away), playdowns, state tournaments, and any tournaments affiliated with the Hudson Hockey Association.
 - Most coaches do carry an extra set of game jerseys in case a player forgets theirs.
 - HHA jerseys are not allowed to be worn for non-affiliated HHA events.
- HHA provides each player a practice jersey. For practices, only the distributed HHA branded practice jersey is allowed. Jerseys from sponsors, AAA teams or others are not approved to be worn for HHA activities.
 - We understand there are times a player forgets their practice jersey. In these one-off scenarios a different jersey can be worn for that practice
- Players must wear regulation HHA socks as issued by the Hudson Hockey Association for all games (home and away), playdowns, state tournaments, and any tournaments affiliated with the Hudson Hockey Association
 - Coaches do not carry additional socks.
 - For practices, any sock type is ok although navy/grey/white socks are encouraged.

Helmet Stickers:

Only the following stickers are allowed to be placed on any HHA player's helmet and the listed guidelines for placement on the helmet must be followed. Any stickers not meeting the following guidelines and/or placement instructions are not followed, the player will be asked to remove them prior to participating in any HHA on/off ice events that require the use of a helmet.

- One (1) HHA Board Approved Logo sticker may be placed on both the upper left and upper right side of the helmet.



- Navy blue player numbers not larger than 2" may be placed on the back of the helmet and care must be taken to ensure they do not cover any portion of the HECC sticker placed on the helmet by the manufacturer.
- Memorial stickers must be approved for use by the HHA Board and will be handled on a case-by-case basis.

Goalies:

Goalie gear:

Must remain within the HHA gear colors of white, navy, or black. This includes breezers, leg pads, catcher, and blocker.

Goalie Helmets:

- Non-wrapped or painted helmets must be HHA colors of white, navy or black
- Wrapped/painted helmets are allowed but must be consistent with HHA branding and colors and not contain any offensive imagery or language. Helmets ordered prior to Dec 1st, 2023 will be grandfathered in.

Team Apparel:

HHA does not require teams to have off ice uniforms. If teams chose to have uniforms, the decision must be unanimous, and votes taken confidentially. Any apparel purchased for team uniforms must use official HHA Branding if being used for HHA affiliated events.
