• FHIT has a roof issue due to humidity in the area (dripping from ceiling). Both long-term and short-term solutions are being researched and tested.

# **Operations Manager Update:**

- Advertising Sponsorship & Invoicing it was brought to my attention this week that there are a handful of advertising payments that are past due. I will start contacting those on Monday to get them squared up. In the future Joanne will be sending me AR reports on a Monthly basis to remedy this happening again. I am getting more inquiries from potential new sponsors with the new season approaching. All are being sent the options and an invitation to come tour the facility to see them in place and how they look in person.
- Replied to a few inquiries, otherwise the report is the same as last month. All Sponsor invoicing is current, still have a couple in the works but communication is tough with targeted one right now.
- Golf Fundraiser The event was held Friday 8/9 with 152 paid golfers signed up and 144
  attending. Event ran well. Currently following up with committed sponsors to get payments
  collected on a few. Overall amount raised looks to be down slightly, but actual numbers will
  not be available until mid-September. Wrap up meeting to go over what worked and what
  didn't will be held this coming week.
- Sportsman's Raffle Online registration has opened up and sales have gotten off to a good start. Tickets and posters will be ready for pick up early next week.
- Invitational Tournaments Registrations still coming in and tournaments are filling up nicely. Report showing confirmed tournament teams was provided. The Jamboree registrations started coming in this past month, as of now 10 of 16 Mite 3, 10 of 16 Mite 2, and 2 of 16 U8 Girls spots have been filled.
- Learn to Skate Summer sessions went well, Financial Summary is attached. The Fall/Winter registration did open on time and to date there have been 96 registrations.
- Tenants -
  - FHIT/MAP wraps up the Summer sessions today, Fall schedule starts Tuesday 9/3. I have received their planned schedule for 2025.
  - Pro Shop rental has been resolved, Jim will report. I will work with them to get payment schedule set up and invoiced accordingly.
  - The Havoc Home game schedule is set and has been entered into the system, they will be starting practice the week of September 16th.
  - Nothing new on concessions.
- Room Rentals Rentals and inquiries are the same, slow and steady. We were asked for and
  donated the use of the RCU room to the Felland family so it could host his celebration of life
  gathering. The family asked that in lieu of flowers donations be made to HHA. Donations have
  been received both from the family and individuals in his name.
- Off Season Ice Rentals Still getting bookings and off season is still filling up nicely so far.
  - o 2023 Ice Booking Report 3/15 to 11/15 2,629 hours (was down from 2022 a bit)
  - o 2024 Ice Booking Report 3/15 to 11/15 2,492 hours (currently ahead of 2022)
  - o Two AAA tournament weekends in August.
- Rink Rats Running as it should be, nothing to report. A note has been sent to all participants that Neck guards are now required.
- Misc. Items/Notes Tournament committee formation process for this upcoming season has begun, will hold an initial planning meeting the week after Labor day.

- Ice Scheduling for next season has started
- FHIT/MAP schedule is entered as well as FLAG Hockey. I am working with other large renters to get their ice reserved soon as well. There are several hours of "new" rentals coming for the next off-season, so starting very early to make sure ice use and employee staffing can be done as efficiently as possible.
- Reaching out to HHA committees for their needs next Fall in hopes we have all needs reserved before the end of March 2025, START YOUR PLANNING NOW while committee members are engaged, waiting until June/July/August meetings to discuss has proven historically to be too late.
- Fully intend to have Fall 2025 needs for Learn to Skate, Try Hockey, 4on4 league, Girls
  Pre Season Clinic, and Tryouts themselves in the system and scheduled before the end
  of this upcoming season. Your efforts to help get to that goal will be greatly needed
  and appreciated.
