- 2. I will attend every practice and game that is reasonably possible and notify my coach if I cannot attend.
- 3. I will do my very best to listen and learn from my coaches.
- 4. I will work hard to improve my skills.
- 5. I will learn the rules of hockey and abide by them.
- 6. I will not touch or take any equipment that does not belong to me.
- 7. I will treat my coaches, teammates, officials, parents, and opponents with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or abilities, and will expect to be treated accordingly.
- 8. I deserve to have fun during my hockey experience and will alert parents and coaches if it stops being fun.
- 9. I deserve to play in an alcohol and drug free environment and expect adults to respect that wish.
- 10.1 will encourage my parents to be involved with my team in some capacity because it's important to me.
- 11.I will do my very best in school.
- 12.I will never enter the playing surface or players bench area while the ice is being resurfaced.
- 13.I will not go on the ice until my coach or an on-ice official instructs me to do so.
