

Moose Youth Hockey Association Jamboree Guidelines 2025

- A. Medical attendants will be provided for each game, as recognized by USA Hockey.**
- B. Game Clocks will be 45-minute running time.**
- C. All games will be half-ice, 4v4 at coaches' discretion. No goalies, unless agreed upon with opposing teams.**
- D. There will be a five-minute warm-up prior to the beginning of each game.**
- E. All teams should report to the Moose Sherritt Hockey Arena at least 45 minutes prior to their scheduled game time. Teams must be ready to play 15 minutes prior to the scheduled game time. The host Director(s) reserves the right to advance game times up to 15 minutes. Rosters will be limited to only 20 players.**
 - I. Locker room assignments (there must always be a locker room attendant; must be gender appropriate,) jamboree schedule, and MN Hockey sanction certificate will be posted in the arena.
 - II. Each team shall have a credential package consisting of an approved USA Hockey player roster form, certified confirmation of birth age, and Team membership application. This package must be available for inspection within 30 minutes upon request from the Tournament Director or any game official. There will be a maximum of 4 coaches allowed on the bench, all coaches must be certified through USA Hockey (or Canada Hockey). Any injured player on the bench (whether dressed or not) must wear a helmet with a full-face guard.
 - III. The Moose Youth Hockey Association will not be responsible for any medical expense incurred due to injury while participating in this jamboree.
 - IV. Any unsportsmanlike conduct from coaches, players or fans will NOT BE TOLERATED. Moose Youth Hockey Association reserves the right to eject any person or team for abusing referees, jamboree officials, other teams, or other fans.
 - V. The Home Tournament Director's and/or Moose Hockey Mites Director's decisions will be final in any and all matters not addressed in the preceding rules.
 - VI. Registration fee for the jamboree is \$400.00.

Coaches and Teams

Coaches will be accountable for the conduct of players in the buildings.

- No food allowed in locker rooms
- No throwing of any objects (tape, ice, snow, pucks, etc.)
- No taunting or unsportsmanlike behavior toward players, referees, or fans
- No profanity
