II. Approval of the minutes

III. Public Comment

- Mike Schlicksup (5-minute limit)
 - Believes in maximum player development and growth of the Cyclones
 - After talking with multiple 14U families, there is a perception that there are no plans OR a plan has been made but not communicated openly.
 - Some 14U families feel that plans/decisions are being hidden or miscommunicated and that leads to a lack of trust
 - He requests that the Board announce the plan for a second 14U team if the numbers warrant it.
 - More players may sign up if we announce the plan.

 - Nothing to report

- President – Ashley Courier
 - Flight has been acquired by Ninja Kidz Action Parks
 - Krista attended a Hockey Meeting and will need to follow (see Ashley's email)
 - Have to declare for Nationals for the 15th of May with \$750 deposit
 - Ice time cost will be increasing 2-3%
 - Three people applied for the VP position

V. Old business

- Travel Tryout Registration Numbers: As of 4/21/26
 - 10U-14
 - 12U-19
 - 14U-18
 - 16U-13
 - 18U-4

- Announcement of 2nd 14U Team and Coach
 - Based on numbers we do not have enough players to announce a second team. Rosters can be up to 20 and we only have 18 signed up for try out as of today.
 - Because of the higher number of injuries and penalties at this level, we need to carry a higher roster at 14U.
 - We would need at least 35 players to consider 2 teams
 - And just because people sign up doesn't mean they come for try-outs or accept a spot.
 - Tournament team is another possibility.
 - There is another age group (12) that has higher numbers and a second team that has not been addressed for that group either.

- We face the possibility of two teams almost every year and historically it hasn't panned out.
- We have ice scheduled for the next weekend for a second try out if players come from other organizations to play for the Cyclones or other circumstances.
- The goal is to have two teams.

VI. New business

- Parliamentarian (Cindy Warnix)
 - Cindy suggested we need someone versed in Robert's Rules of Order and compliance to serve the organization
 - Ashley requested being president a few months to see if this is really necessary. She needs a few meetings to get settled in.
 - This person would not be a voting member
- VP Election according to Bylaws (Ashley Courier)
 - Per the by-laws we need to this vote during the regular season
 - Propose we do the election at Back to Hockey
 - It was noted that in the By-Laws, under "Vacancies," any Board can fill a position temporarily (until the main election) with a majority vote of the Board. We don't want to do that vote today as Board did not know about this, but will put a vote on the agenda for next meeting.

 - Please consider a volunteer position in these areas
- Travel Team Budgets (Ashley Courier)
- Updating Bylaws (Ashley Courier)
 - The by-laws need to be updated.
 - The organization can get grants to do reviews and updates for free.
 - Propose using CAHA grant this year for this purpose.
