CYCLONE CODE OF CONDUCT

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. No derogatory, offensive, or abusive language on the bench, in the rink, or at any team function.
2. No lashing out at any official, regardless of the call. The coaching staff will handle all matters pertaining to officiating.
3. Anyone who receives a penalty must skate directly to the penalty box.
4. Fighting will not be tolerated. Fighting will result in an appearance before the Disciplinary Committee.
5. You must follow the rules of the facility regarding alcohol consumption. CCYHA is 100% tobacco-free (including, but not limited to, vapes, e-cigarettes, chewing tobacco, etc.). Tobacco products may not be used on the bench, in locker rooms, or in the penalty box during practices or games. The use of illegal substances at any team function is strictly prohibited.
6. Conduct yourself in a respectful and appropriate manner at all facilities, including ice rinks, hotels, restaurants, and other locations during team functions.
7. Any player, team official, coach, parent, or Cyclones representative who violates this Code of Conduct may be subject to disciplinary action, including possible removal from the association.
