CSDHL

- Peewee major application was denied. Plan is to enter the 2013 team at Red tier 1 (highest prospect level). Levels are Red, White, Blue (tier 1 and tier 2 @ each color).
- Prospects application with tentative team count and placement levels is due July 20th. Tommy will decide initial team placements.
- Prospects will have a "seeding" round, followed by team reshuffling if needed. By October 26th. Nov 8th will be the regular season. Jan 24 season ends. Peoria rule still in effect for prospects except the Red division.
- No girls teams are allowed in CSDHL. Time 12 min for squirt, 14 min for peewee, overtime format: 3v3 no shootout.
- Every game on Game Sheets. Will need to figure out the ipad situation. Charging has been challenging. Perhaps use charging bricks.
- Aug 29 Applications are finalized. Brackets start being put together after that.
- Top 8 teams make the playoffs, round robin. Goal for 20 game regular season. 14 and up no peoria rule.
