- Need D10 Mandatory Coaches Meeting dates once available (usually end of Oct/early Nov.)

- Bantam A staff needs assistant* (Tony McGee, Nick Johnston)

Ice Scheduler (Tim Hansen)

- Skills Sessions for skaters and goalies have been finalized
 - Mite goalie training will be scheduled after game scheduling is complete
- The October schedule is almost complete. Doing some final adjustments and reviews.
 - Mites are figured to start October 6. Will forward the spreadsheet to Dan Ritter to start populating.
- I started blocking off time slots for games. All games need to be backed up. Bantam AA and As will need to utilize the 100 min ice time slot. We need to submit our times to D10 by October 13. Note that there is a ripple effect with just changing one time/team.
- Please inform me of any conversations that are had if it relates to ice scheduling. Tryout time changes, tournament schedules, ice swap sheet/changes. Rink managers will contact me directly to change times or utilize dead ice.
- Coaches/Manager reminders (I can attend the coaches and managers meeting if it helps. Please give me enough notice if my attendance is needed/wanted):
 - Let Matt know of any scrimmages, home or away, so he can let me know to get them into avario. This will avoid any ice scheduling double ups and help manage the team's ice touches.

- They cannot schedule any additional tournaments once D10 starts their game scheduling process. I need to upload all our game times to D10s website before October 13.
- I cannot post games to the teams website before D10 gives approval.
 Sometimes other organizations will upload theirs prior to approval. Once they are uploaded to your team page we encourage all managers and coaches to review and also cross reference the D10 website. We do make mistakes and this will help catch one that might sneak through.
- o Once the D10 schedule is posted, it is final. No changes can be made.
- I schedule ice that is allocated to RYHA from the RAC and SR. A team can always go out and purchase additional ice at their own expense. If this happens, The traveling directors and I need to know about this.
- Bantams will get most of the 9PM and later start times. There will be times a
 peewee team will start after 9PM. Squirts could start as late as 8:30PM. There
 are a lot of moving pieces that go into especially once games and tournaments
 start. We do our best to not give all the late starts to one team.
