- We will experience ice shortages due to both youth and HS games. These are out of our control and we will do our best to get each team their practices. Each team can check the availability of morning practices, the outdoor rink, or can contact other ice rinks on their own to purchase additional ice at their own expense if they have a few days off and need ice
