

Recommended Bat Sizing Chart

Level	Age	Length	Drop Rating	Certification
T-Ball	5 and 6	24"-26"	(-13.5)--(-12)	T-ball, USA-Bats, USSSA
Colts	7 and 8	26"-29"	(-13.5)--(-10)	USA-Bats
Minors	9 and 10	28"-30"	(-12)--(-9)	USA-Bats
Majors	11 and 12	29"-32"	(-11)--(-8)	USA-Bats
14U/Teeners	13 and 14	30"-33"	-3	BBCOR
Teeners	13-16	31"-34"	-3	BBCOR

Notes:

1. These measurements are strictly a recommendation. Bat lengths and weights are not mandated.

2. Bat certifications are mandated. Certification labels are located on the bat itself.

3. Drop rating is the weight of the bat. Drop rating is calculated by subtracting the weight of the bat from the length (Example: a 30-inch bat that weighs 20-ounces is a drop 10 (-10) bat. A 30-inch bat that weighs 18-ounces is a drop 12 (-12) bat.

4. Solid wood bats are permitted at any level (bamboo bats are not permitted).
