The Appleton Lacrosse Club Board met on May 20 at North High School to review club finances, program updates, summer planning, and end-of-season activities.

Financial Update

The club remains in a strong financial position with approximately \$54,000 across checking and savings accounts. The board reviewed fundraising results, upcoming expenses, and ongoing budget planning for the 2025–2026 fiscal year.

Fundraising & Sponsorships

The season raffle raised over \$13,000 with strong member participation. Additional fundraising efforts included restaurant nights, Kwik Trip card sales, and apparel sales. Sponsor recognition efforts will continue through social media and end-of-season communications.

Girls & Boys Program Updates

The girls program is preparing for its end-of-season recognition event on June 2.

The board also discussed player development and team structure within the boys 14U program. For the Verona Tournament, the club approved a combined roster approach focused on competitive play and player development.
