 - v) High School, two candidates, Keith Allen, Brooke McArdle: Brooke has coached for past two years. Played college hockey at NCAA level, started playing when I was 4. Hockey has been my life. I expect a lot from my players. We are trying to win games. I do keep the fun in the game. I coach systems. I will be hard on players when necessary. Only coach to have a team beat every single team in the league. Hockey league in WV is growing. We had a lot of kids playing in Pittsburgh. Team WV allows us to keep WV hockey growing. Good relationships with people in Wheeling, which allows us to keep going back to state tourney. The goal is to go to nationals. Looking for 26-30 games. Ky High School league is pretty much the only one we can play in. I have reached out to another Wheeling player to help. He's on board as an assistant. Having another young, non-parent coach is great for high school team. I give lessons, My commitment to this organization is evident. I have people in place to evaluate and rank for tryouts. The 14U situation, my goal is to get everyone playing on the roster. We're going to have to have a set 20 (18 skaters, 2 goalies); That would be the primary team. Others would be 14U as primary team. In contact with someone to make new jerseys. Do have a sponsor who will cover majority of that cost. \$80 for two jerseys.

Keith: Goals very similar to Brooke. Way to get to goals is a bit different. Structure. I've coached for 12-13 years, 14U before COVID leaned on structure and team principles to grow. There's a ton of talent coming out of this rink for past few years, it's important we do put wins and losses and ships as a measure of success. More broadly, it's not just about this year. It's about a program that will have sustained success and keep kids coming back to help with program. Number of games is a moving target. Will have to accommodate team WV. There will be a need to have relationship with 14U coach, because there will be multiple 14U 9th graders eligible to play. Skill fit for where they're at. We've got big skill discrepancies. Important to put those kids in situations where they're making plays, developing, getting better. I have a son who plays at WVU, no. 1 priority. Going to look at group around me to handle any situation where I might not

be available. Team around me that's not just assistant coaches but will schedule games that fit to reduce conflicts. Talked to Abel Vir, Paul Page to help. Engaging adult hockey folks to get involved in our youth organization. Similar to Brooke on tryouts. Ninth graders on that 20 person roster, would work with parents and 14U coach to see what's best for player.

Board has elected Brooke McArdle (8-3) as high school coach; Ben makes, motion, Amanda seconds, motion passes. 27 kids eligible to play high school, 15 are coming up from 14U, 7 not eligible for 14U anymore.
