The 2025–26 season has been another fantastic year for the Wayzata Girls Basketball Association, with strong participation, skill development, and the continued support of our amazing volunteer community of coaches, parents, and fans!

Our 4th–12th grade rec program is nearly wrapped up, with 166 players across 17 teams enjoying a season filled with growth, teamwork, and fun thanks to our wonderful volunteer coaches. Our 2nd and 3rd grade rec program also had a fantastic year, with 120+ girls on 18 teams and 70+ volunteer coaches. Based on strong demand, we expanded the program this year by adding 7 additional weeks to the season, giving players even more time on the court to build skills and confidence.

Across 4th–8th grade travel, 19 teams competed in nearly 200 tournaments, earning 47 championships and 105 podium finishes. These teams finished the season with 381 wins, scoring 18,000+ points while holding opponents to just over 15,000, resulting in an impressive +2,787 scoring margin—a testament to the depth and development across the program. Our 3rd grade Intro Travel program provided a great introduction to tournament play, with three teams competing in 15 tournaments, earning 39 wins and scoring nearly 1,000 points while gaining valuable experience ahead of the full travel program.

Congratulations to all of our players, and thank you to the volunteer coaches, families, and community who make this program possible!
