- **Sign Ups**

 - Used the list of Oldtimers to invite individuals to register
 - Drew from the waitlist to fill out teams based on team needs, skill level, and fit with Oldtimers's philosophy of play.

To Discuss

- **Should we expand to 8 teams?**
 - We have the opportunity to obtain an additional sheet of ice at the Dipper on Sunday at 8:00
 - If picked up that sheets, we could support 8 teams with a similar number of byes
 - Effect on registration fee – essentially a wash
 - *General consensus is to expand to 8 teams if we can reserve the ice and there is enough participants to warrant an 8th team.*
- **Should we raise the minimum age to 40, generally grandfathering in existing <40s or just continue to give preference to older skaters?**
- **Max number of goals per player per game**
 - Should we change it from 2 to 1?
- **Picking up players**
 - This year changed to: In general, if under 9 players can pick up skaters to attain 9, but only after consulting team reps

- o Stressed communication between reps to come up with reasonable solutions.
- **Number of goals per pick-up player per game**
 - o This year we set this at 1 goal. How did it go?
- **Should players provide a contact person in case of injury? If so, how would it be administered?** *Emergency contact list will be provided to scorekeeper*
- **End of the year draft tourney?**
