

2026 Season Costs

Season Fee Overview

- Each team will be charged a fee to participate in the WPYLA League.
- Fees are to be paid by the designated deadline.
- A LATE FEE of \$50/team will be charged for late payments.
- If payment is not received 5 days before season scheduling begins, any team with a past due balance will be ineligible to participate in the season.

Season WPYLA Fees

8U - \$25

10U - \$500*

12U - \$500*

14U - \$500*

*Includes the end of season tournament. The fee is \$100 for any team that wants to participate in the regular season only. Due to facility and scheduling limitations, it will not be possible to add the tournament after registration.

Season Referee Fees

10U - \$60/official (1 per game)

12U - \$75/official (2 per game)

14U

- 2 referees - \$75/official (\$150/game)
- 3 referees - \$70/official (\$210/game)

Season Arbiter Scheduling and Referee Assignment Fee

- All 10U, 12U, & 14U teams will be charged \$100/team
- Invoices will be provided to Member Programs by Matt Martin
- All Member Programs are required to pay Matt Martin promptly
- No referees will be assigned if Member Programs are past due on payments to Matt Martin

2026 Season Costs

2026 Season Fines

WPYLA will be imposing fees/fines for various infractions in 2026. **It is the WPYLA Board of Director's expectation that \$0 be collected in fines.** This is not an attempt to raise money for the league. Fines are being introduced to bring structure to the league and reduce issues with missed deadlines.

- Late Player Roster submission - \$50/roster if a complete and accurate player roster is not received by the deadline.
- Late Coach Roster submission - \$50/roster if a complete and accurate coach roster is not received by the deadline.
- Late Schedule submission - \$50/schedule if a complete and accurate schedule is not received by the deadline.
- Ineligible (suspended, not on roster, etc.) player participated in a game - \$100
- Ineligible (suspended, not on roster, etc.) coach on the sideline - \$250
- No-Show or Last-Minute Cancellation
 - Any team that no-shows a game or cancels at the last minute must pay ALL associated fees for that game. This includes EMTs, refs, and field usage.
 - A cancellation is considered last-minute only when refs, EMTs, and fields cannot be cancelled.
 - All programs are required to review the WPYLA and Arbiter websites to ensure that the schedule is accurate.
 - Any issues with either the WPYLA or Arbiter websites are to be communicated to Matt Martin and WPYLA when identified.
 - Example: At the WPYLA Scheduler's Meeting, Team A and Team B agree to play each other on May 1st with team A hosting. On May 1st, Team B does not show up for the game. Team B will owe Team A for all costs for the day.
 - Total Cost = \$500
 - EMT - \$150
 - Refs - \$150 total
 - Field Cost - \$200
 - Team B must pay Team A directly. Team B is responsible for ensuring that WPYLA is informed of the payment.
 - All No-Show/Late-Cancellation fees must be paid prior to the end of season tournament or Team B will not be eligible to participate in the tournament.

WPYLA reserves the right to adjust these fees/fines, as necessary.
