

2025-2026 SEASON UPDATE

Wausau Youth Hockey Families,

I hope this message finds you well as we approach the final month of the school year and eagerly anticipate summer. As we begin to gear up for the 2025-2026 hockey season, I want to provide you with a brief overview of our plans and developments.

Our newly elected board is diligently working this offseason to enhance our organization. Key initiatives include updating association policies, improving core skills development at each age level, clarifying coaching expectations, and streamlining communication.

Another focus this offseason centers around creating a competitive atmosphere. Many parent surveys commented on our skaters not being in shape or putting forth effort in games. This is not about winning and losing. This is about fostering an environment that encourages hard play, sportsmanship, teamwork, resilience and setting expectations. Effort needs to be shown not only in games but also in practice.

In recent news regarding rink funding, Marathon County has approved a \$690,000 allocation to ensure the MP2 facility remains operational. While this funding will improve functionality through a mat system and other necessary items, it is a temporary solution. The county is actively seeking a long-term strategy for the rink's future, and I, alongside other user groups, am contributing ideas to this effort. As there is progress regarding the rinks, I will be sure to keep you informed.

However, due to the increased funding from the county, we will face a rise in our ice cost to \$165 per hour, significantly impacting our operating budget. Consequently, registration fees will rise by \$25 per skater next year. While this increase will not fully address the shortfall, our goal is to keep participation accessible and ensure we retain our skaters without an undue financial burden.

I understand the concerns regarding how our fees are utilized. Please know that the funds we pay for ice time do not directly support the rink's maintenance but rather contribute to the broader Marathon County Parks Department budget. I share your frustration and want to assure you that we are advocating for better resource allocation.

Thank you for your ongoing support and commitment to Wausau Youth Hockey. We look forward to an exciting off-season as we gear up for the season ahead. Stay tuned for more updates!
