Notes:

Goal differential is capped at 7 goals (i.e., there is no advantage in the Power Rankings to beating a team by more than 7 goals).

Power ranking (which is numerical representation of a team's competitive strength) has been added to help coaches understand relative strength of each team.

Strength of schedule is equal to the average normalized PR for a team's opponents.

Forfeits are not included in the power rankings or in team records.

Power ranking uncertainty is high when a team's Power Rank is much higher than their strength of schedule

(particularly when high percentage of games decided by > 7 goals).

Indicates conference winners (or potential winners)
