



Job Title: Women's Lacrosse Head (Varsity) and Assistant (JV) Coaching Team (2 positions)

Location: Lincoln High School (in the Seattle Public School District)

Job Type: Seasonal with most commitment during the Spring Season (late Feb-early May)

Overview:

Lincoln High School in Seattle is seeking coaching staff for its Women's Lacrosse Team. We are looking to recruit both a head and assistant coach to lead our V and JV teams.

Both teams are WSLA members, but it is not a school-sponsored sport. The team is run by coaches and student leaders and governed by a parent board. The lacrosse team provides an opportunity for students to compete, grow, and enjoy lacrosse in a supportive and inclusive environment. The coaches will work closely with each other and student leaders to organize practices, lead skill development, and guide the team during games.

Key Responsibilities:

- Serve as a mentor, leader, and positive role model for student-athletes.
- Plan and lead engaging practices that promote individual and team development.
- Teach proper techniques, game strategy, and lacrosse fundamentals in a safe, inclusive manner.
- Support student leaders in scheduling games, organizing transportation, and coordinating events.
- Attend and coach all games, tournaments, and team functions as agreed upon with the club.
- Foster a team culture that emphasizes respect, effort, sportsmanship, and fun.

- Ensure player safety at all times, including maintaining basic first aid knowledge and awareness of emergency procedures.
- Communicate effectively with students and parents/guardians.
- Support the team in fundraising, equipment management, and budgeting as needed.

Required Qualifications:

- Experience playing or coaching lacrosse (women's or co-ed) at the youth, club, or high school level
- Ability to work collaboratively with students and school staff in a mentorship capacity.
- Enthusiastic, flexible, and student-centered coaching style.
- Ability to pass a background check in accordance with school or district policy.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Previous experience working with high school students in a coaching or teaching role.
- First Aid/CPR certification (or willingness to obtain).

Compensation:

This is a **stipend** position. Compensation details to be discussed during the hiring process.

Note: This is a **club sport**, not a sanctioned varsity program. The team is student-organized and operates with support from parent volunteers.
