



ARBUTUS ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTION

1. What league does Arbutus Athletic Association play in?

Arbutus football & cheer is a part of the Carroll County Youth Football League. This league is comprised of approximately 11 teams throughout the Baltimore, Carroll, Frederick, Harford and Montgomery counties along with Baltimore City. 2. Who can sign up?

Anyone! Football players ages 5-13 on or before August 1st, are eligible to play and Cheerleaders ages 4-14 regardless of sex, race, ethnicity or nationality. Each participant must be registered and turn in a valid Identification Card. (Please refer to question #5 regarding ID cards).

3. What are the fees for football & cheerleading and what equipment is provided?

REGISTRATION FEES ARE AS FOLLOWS: (CASH, CREDIT OR MONEY ORDER ONLY)

Football age is as of Aug 1st / Cheer is based off of birth year for team placement

FOOTBALL Non-competitive Ages 5-6yrs: \$185.00

FOOTBALL Ages 7 & older: \$200.00

Football provides: Helmet, shoulder pads, practice jersey & pants, game jersey & pants, mouthpiece, and game socks.

Football players must provide: Protective cup & cleats.

CHEERLEADING PERFORMANCE (INCLUDES FUTURES) AGES 4-5: \$185.00 & AGES 6-14: \$200.00 Includes: Summer game day uniform (dress/bow) and winter game day uniform (long sleeve/outerwear/bow). Please see the season details on the website for what items parents are responsible for.

CHEERLEADING COMPETITIVE - Ages 7 & older: \$200.00 additional fee will be charged upon making a competitive team. Cheerleading provides: Summer Uniform skirt, competition uniform, bows, competition fees. Please see the season details on the website for what items parents are responsible for.

4. Can I get a refund if my child decides not to play?

A request for refund must be made in writing to our organization. No exceptions. This can be a simple note with child's name, requesters name, address for refund, and a phone number where you can be reached, a short reason why. No refunds will be issued unless there is a request in writing and it includes all of the above information. Refunds will be issued by check only and can take up to 2-3 weeks to be issued.

PRO-RATED REFUND SCHEDULE:

Prior to the first day of practice 100% refunded

After 1st practice 100% refunded

After 2nd practice 0% refunded

We recognize that you may wish to withdraw for a variety of reasons, but our policy encourages early decisions so as to not affect other players and our ability to efficiently run the program. The Board of Directors may take into consideration a significant change in a player or cheerleader's medical condition or other extenuating circumstances.

5. Why does my child need an ID card and where do I get one?

All football players regardless of age are required to have a CCFL League ID in-order to participate in the league activities. All IDs will be turned into the head coach by a designated date. Any athlete who fails to provide their ID by the date will not be able to participate until one is received. Cheerleaders will not be issued a uniform until the card is received and may not compete without one.

CCYFL is now requiring ALL football players from 5-6 to 13U to have CCYFL ID's. They will be able to obtain them on the August weigh-in day. Price is \$10 for 1 year or \$20 for 2 years. The ID form will be given out closer to the August date from your team rep. More details are provided on our website www.arbutusgoldeneagles.com.

6. Where will practices take place and how often?

Practices will be held at Arbutus Middle School. Due to limited practice space teams may practice on different days of the week. Football will practice on the upper, lower and Shelbourne Road field. Cheerleading will practice on the grass area in front of the school and nearby courts. During the summer months (before Baltimore County Schools begin) teams are allowed unlimited practice. A schedule will be determined by each Head Coach and the Athletic Director. Once school is in session, practices will be reduced to the league maximum six hours per week and will be determined by your child's coach based on field availability. Cheerleaders may move to local schools to provide indoor facilities for colder months.

7. Where will games be played and does everyone travel?

Yes, Football players and Cheerleaders of ALL ages are required to travel to all away games, scrimmage, regular season and/or play-off. All travel is estimated to be up to 1 hour. Once established, league information, schedules and directions to fields will be listed on the CCYFL league website. Coaches will also be sharing the information as the schedule becomes available.

8. How do I know what age group my son or daughter will participate in?

The league has strict guidelines as to where athletes are placed and it is up to the Athletic Directors as to where each athlete is placed, not the coach or parents. It is the job of the Football Athletic Director to ensure every player is placed on the proper team according to age, weight, and experience to the best of his/her ability. It is the job of the Cheerleading Director to ensure every cheerleader is placed on the proper team according to age, and experience to the best of his/her ability.

9. What are these weights referred to and how will I know where my son/daughter is eligible to play football?

10. Do the cheerleaders participate in competitions and how often?

Yes! Along with cheering for all home and away football games, our competitive cheerleaders compete in three competitions each season. All cheerleader entry fees are included in your registration fee except Ocean City. There will be a parent meeting to discuss in detail our Ocean City Competition.

11. Who do I call for inclement weather?

You will receive a notification ASAP from your coach when the weather is bad. Football is played in all weather except LIGHTNING. So if it rains expect to play unless otherwise communicated. Cheerleaders are expected to cheer as long as the game is on. However, Cheerleading will move indoors if it is raining before or during practice if possible.
