Traci provided a report on the upcoming Sr. Games. There are 15 Over 50 teams, 4 Over 65 and 5 Over 70 teams. There will be 3 full size fields and 1 8v8 size field. To enlarge tournament will require more park space somewhere to add additional fields. Traci has some food trucks coming and Sr. Games is providing some canopies and water. Still needs some volunteers.

Several players had expressed desire to stay at Whitman Elementary School.

Unfortunately, youth soccer got to Parks& Recreation before us and has secured the field on Saturdays for this season. There is a potential to permit it in the future if Alcott does not work out. League would have to negotiate with school Principal to be able to move our storage container along with goals to school.

Karin reported that Alcott is looking pretty good. It again has grass that is green like it used to be a few years ago.

Fees – the City raised fees and changed the pay format from paying per field to paying per team. This more than doubled our permit costs. Also chance we will be paying entire bill for porta potty. With that and our other expenses discussion took place about raising fees. Jany Staley made a motion to increase full time player fee to \$85 and part time to \$60. The Motion was seconded by Nancy Gackstetter. The motion passed unanimously. Karin will talk to youth soccer to see if they would be interested in continuing to line the field each week. If not, then will go back to teams for first game performing this task.

The regular season will begin September 20<sup>th</sup> and end December 20<sup>th</sup> at Acott. There will be no games on Thanksgiving weekend and Huntsman Games weekend. We have the field permitted for September 6<sup>th</sup> and after discussion was decided to have an 8:30 am scrimmage for Over 58 and 10:15 am scrimmage for Over 48. This scrimmage will be dependent on whether the referees are available and if we can get the field set up and lined with such short notice.

Nancy has the schedule drafted and will send to Karin for review. Karin and Cindy will finalize registration process and let everyone know when they can notify players they can go on-line to register on POLWSL.com. Players do not go to Crossbar to register. First time players will need to be able to download a copy of their driver's license while registering. All players must register each season, sign waiver and pay fee. Once a player has registered and paid then they can use the Crossbar app to see the game schedule and view which players coming to the game. Any player playing on two teams is to contact either Registrar Cindy Suarez or President Karin Lewcock so they can be added to the second team roster after they have registered for the season.

Jany indicated that during the summer things were a little lax. Asking Team Captains to remind players that if a player is wearing a watch they must cover it. Also refrain from hoop earrings and necklaces. Jany will be asking to referees to follow-up.

Several indicated that they felt the Over 48 Summer Session went very well and everyone enjoyed playing with different people and were very flexible. Thanks was given to Cindy Suarez for suggesting and implementing the sign-in system used.

A motion by Erica Lane and seconded by Maire Juergens was made to adjourn the meeting.
