Karin wanted to jump in on item #6 on the Agenda discussing current team status in the Over 48 division. A discussion took place on whether wanted to reduce number of teams due to several teams hurting for players or consider playing 8 aside rather than 11 aside. Team Captains want to retain the 11 aside format.

This discussion then encompassed #5 on Agenda how to handle occasional players. Talk of a per game fee versus part time fee. Most felt better to keep the part time fee. It was decided for player referrals who want to see what team/league is like that for one game there would be no fee. The player would however, need to go on-line and fill out and sign waiver.

Pia of Hot Tamales will get back to her players about folding the team and discussion about finding a place on another team for anyone that still wants to play. There would be no team placement based not wanting an older player. Results of her discussion to be done by December 10<sup>th</sup> and she will report it to Karin. Other team captains will begin discussion about whether they want to add players to their roster. It was felt with 5 teams and one team each week having a bye that some of those bye players would be available to play with other teams on that Saturday.

Karin will also check out what payment options are available thru Crossbar. It appears Paypal and Venmo are used more by players than Zelle.

Minutes of September 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting were reviewed when they were sent out with no changes/additions/deletions and therefore approved.

Bank Account – Tina stated that the current bank account is \$13,816.

Winter/Spring Season – Season will begin January 24<sup>th</sup> after Hawaii tournament for 14 weeks. There will be byes April 11 for Vegas Tournament and February 14<sup>th</sup> for President's Weekend. Season will end May 9<sup>th</sup>.

Whitman Field – The issues with this field are the neighbors and at present time not open to having a porta potty at site and therefore most likely not want our storage container to be there. We can pursue in future but as Karin indicated our efforts right now are towards rebuilding the Over 48 group.

Rain out games – It was asked if there is ability for a mass email thru Crossbar to be sent out to all players when a game is cancelled due to weather. Karin will check into the ability to do that. Otherwise, Team Captains have the ability thru Crossbar to send emails to their players but not in mass currently.

Elections – There are candidates for three of the 4 positions. No one stepped forward to finish the one year term of Secretary. Miller McCord and Karin Lewcock offered to Co-Chair this position to cover each other when one is unavailable. The following slate of officers was presented:
