MINUTES OF 4/21/25 LEAGUE MEETING

Absent team reps for: Celtics, Fusion, GoGetters

Field Status – Jany reported that the City plans to close the Alcott field May 12th and reopen on July 14th. The plan is to cut existing weeds/grass as low as possible, bring in dirt to fill in the low areas, put down grass seed and mulch. The area will be fenced off and Parks & Rec. has notified the school. The Area Manager Hannah Turner indicated if field needs to be closed past July 14th that they have an alternative field for us to use.

Summer Season – Karin indicated she had to date not asked which teams would be playing the summer season. She indicated that ALPL would not be and felt neither would Fusion since they did not play last summer. Pia indicated that Hot Tamales would be merging with Celtics for the summer but they needed someone to manage for the summer. GoGetters and Flash indicated they will be returning which only leaves us with 3 teams.

After a lengthy discussion it was decided that Team Captains would go back to their teams this week or no later than this coming weekend to find out the following:

1. How many of their players plan to play this summer.
2. If we do not get enough players for 4 teams playing 11 v 11, would players consider playing 8 v 8 to make up 4 teams.
3. Would players (Over 48) want to consider the format (Open Play) played in Scripps Ranch. No set Teams or Team Managers. Folks would go on -line to indicate which of the two days they would plan. A fixed number would be set for those reservations.

Games for the league are preferred to be Tues/Wednesday/Thursdays for Over 48 & Over 58. Karin will contact Team Managers week of April 28th unless Team Captains contact her first. Should indicate which option was favored. Cindy Suarez said willing to help a 4th team (if option 2 taken) as Team Manager. If Option for open play is picked then determine what format will be used for weekly player signups.

Question was asked if we ever completed a contract with the referees. Karin said she started one with Diego but once he decided not to return it has been in limbo. This can be looked into again.

Tina suggested we increase the referee fee to \$75 for the summer since referees have to drive multiple days a week. Karin will determine the cost impact and this can be revisited once we know which way things will go with the summer.

Karin indicated that Sue DeVol wanted the league to consider buying two canopies for use by teams at the field. After a discussion it was decided not to purchase any at this time. Teams can always bring their own canopy or umbrellas. Still issues with some teams not having anyone arrive early for first game to help with lining of fields and moving goals onto the field.

Porty potty has been unlocked because of the number of times the existing locks have been taken. Appears youth does not padlock to fence after opening and kids most likely take them. For the time being will continue without a lock unless someone at the school complains and then will deal with it at that time.

A motion to adjourn the meeting by Karin and seconded by Nancy was made and unanimously approved. Meeting ended at 7:27 pm.
