Scholarship Background

The scholarship was established to benefit graduating seniors of Upper Arlington high School who are members of the varsity or junior varsity Ice Hockey team.

Eligibility Criteria

- Candidates must be graduating seniors of Upper Arlington High School.
- Candidates must play on the Upper Arlington Ice Hockey varsity or junior varsity team.
- Candidates must have a minimum 3.0 grade point average (GPA) on a 4.0 scale.
- Candidates must plan to pursue post-secondary education at any college, university, or community college in the U.S.
- Candidates may attend full- or part-time, but may take no fewer than six credit hours per term.

Selection Criteria

- 25% Academic Achievement
- 25% Community Service
- 25% Essay
- 25% Leadership

Selection Committee

- Head Coach, Upper Arlington Ice Hockey Team
- Representative, Upper Arlington High School (Principal or School Counselor)
- Current Parent, Non-senior
- Current Parent, Non-senior
- Community Member

Award Amount

1000

Renewal Criteria

The scholarship is not renewable.

Payment Instructions

All awards are paid directly to the educational institution.
The scholarship may be used for any educational expenses, provided the recipient is enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours per academic term. The scholarship must not displace any institutional or other aid.

- Educational Information
- Essay: describe how you have demonstrated leadership ability, both on and off the ice.
- Transcript
- Two Letters of Recommendation
- Community Service Activities List (including year and role)

Application and Award Process

- The Columbus Foundation sends notification of the scholarship's availability each year for the upcoming academic year.
- The organization manages the application and selection process.
- Once a recipient has been selected, the organization will provide the recipients' data through the online form at <https://www.columbusfoundation.org/my-account/forms/submission?applicationId=15796> by April 1. The following information will be required for each recipient:

 - o Address
 - o Phone Number
 - o Email Address
 - o Date of Birth
 - o Award Amount
- The Foundation sends an award email to the recipient that explains the payment request process and includes the proof of enrollment form.
- Once proof of enrollment has been submitted and approved by the Foundation, a check will be sent to the recipient's educational institution.
