Team Fees

Team fees are additional monthly charges collected by the designated team treasurer. These fees cover expenses such as tournament entry costs, coaches' travel and per diem, team manager travel, team supplies, miscellaneous extras, end-of-season gifts, and the team party. Team fees are based on actual expenses incurred during the current season, but can be estimated based on team fees charged in prior seasons. Team fees are divided equally among all players and cannot be paid using scholarships.
